

Unduplicated 12-month headcount and total FTE, by student level: 2017-18




Enrollment by gender, student level, and full- and part-time status: Fall 2017




Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2017




Percent of all students enrolled, by age: Fall 2017








Graduation rates of full-time, first-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates within 150% of normal time to program completion, by Title IV aid status: 2011 cohort


Award and enrollment rates of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who entered the institution in 2009-10, by cohort


Percent distribution of core revenues, by source: Fiscal year 2017


