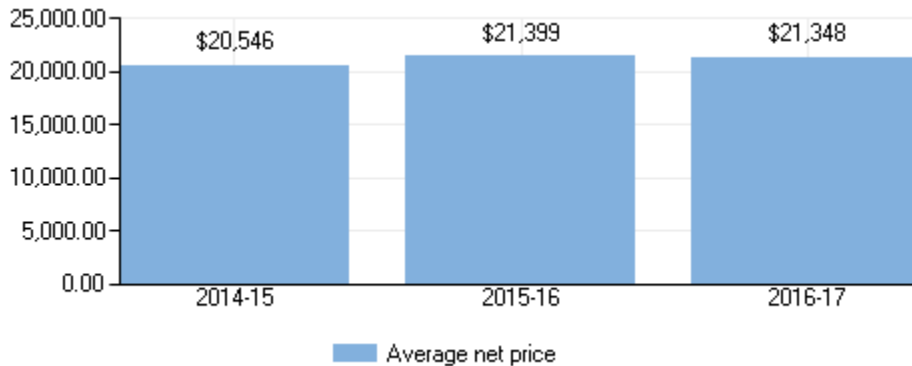

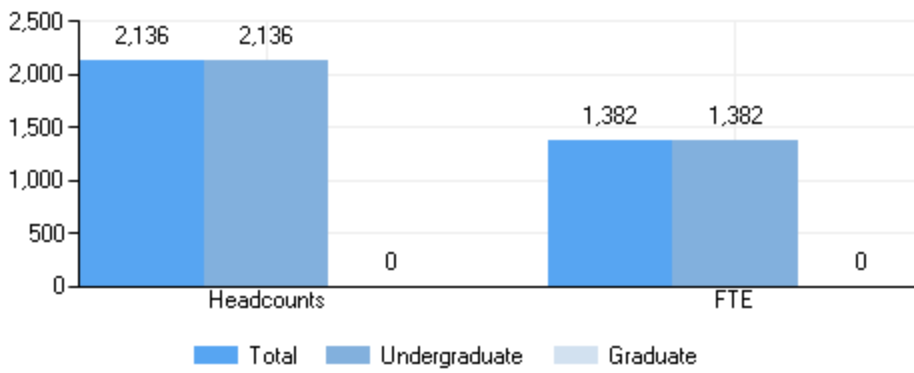

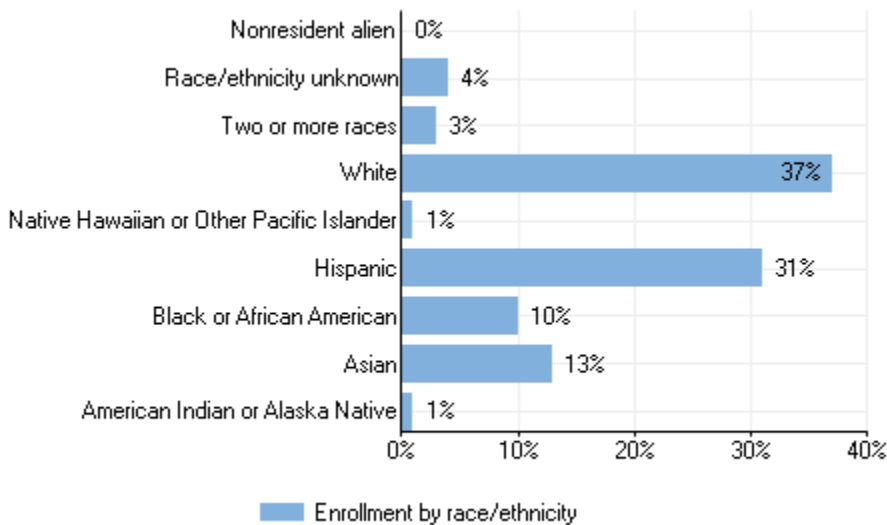
### Unduplicated 12-month headcount and total FTE, by student level: 2017-18



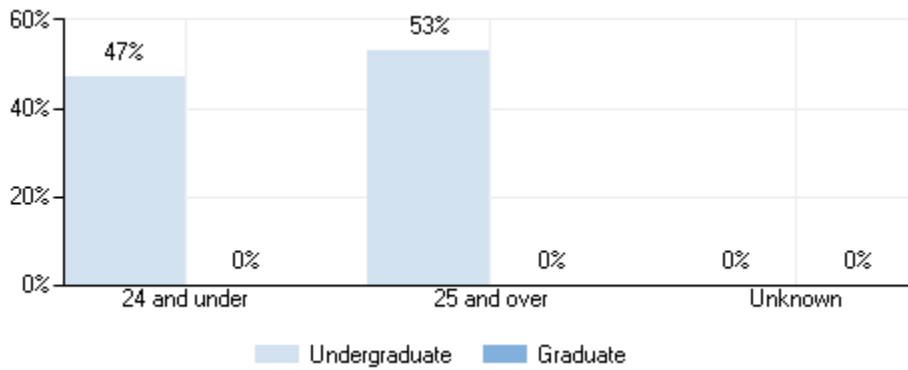

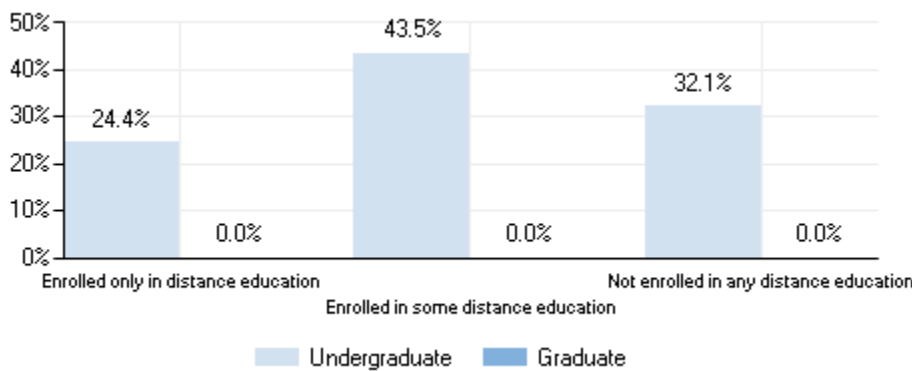
**Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2017**



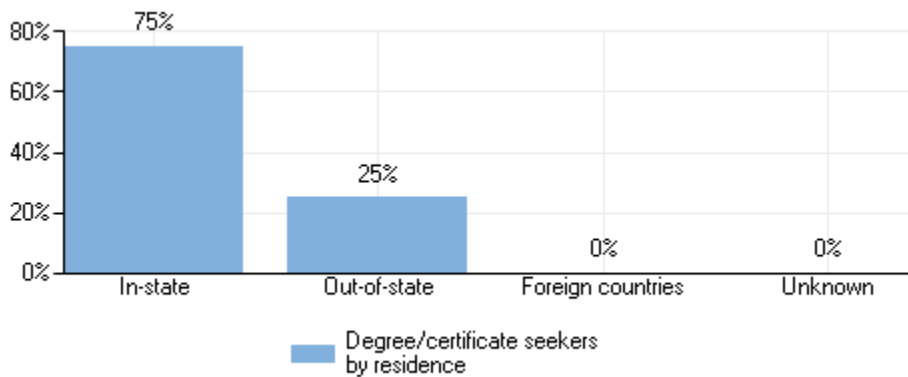
### Percent of all students enrolled, by age: Fall 2017

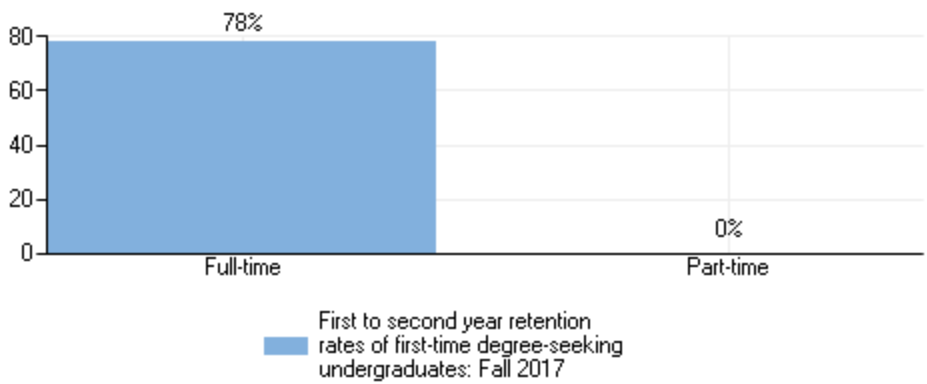

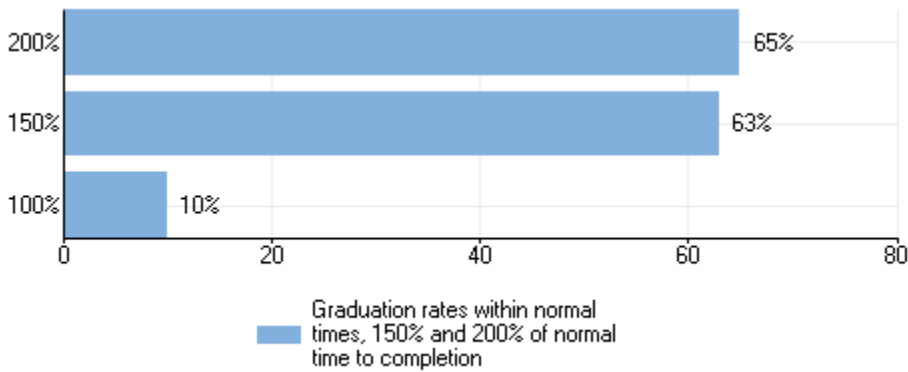

### First to second year retention rates of first-time degree-seeking undergraduates: Fall 2017



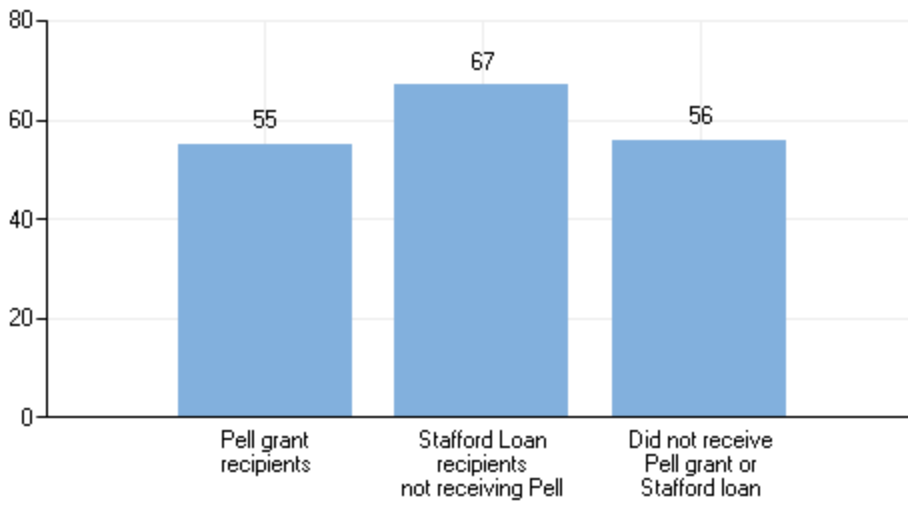

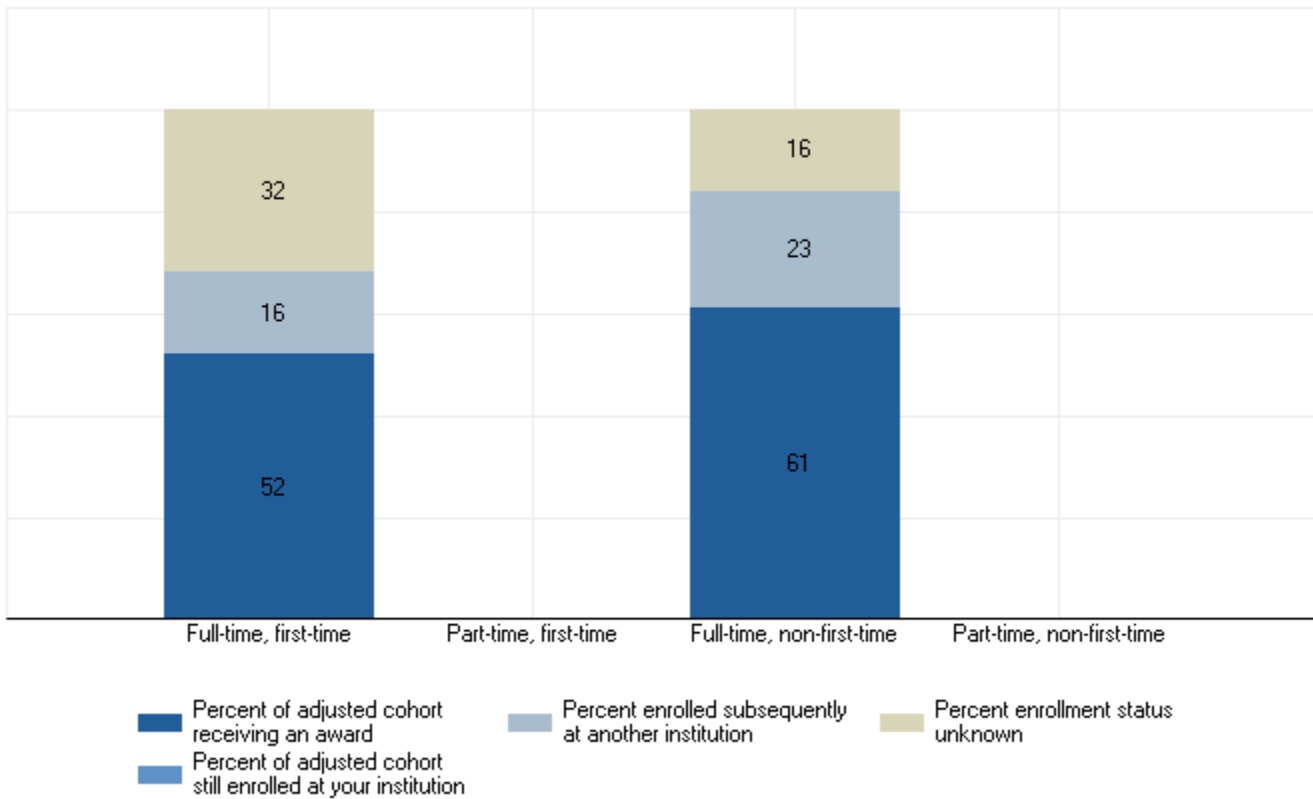

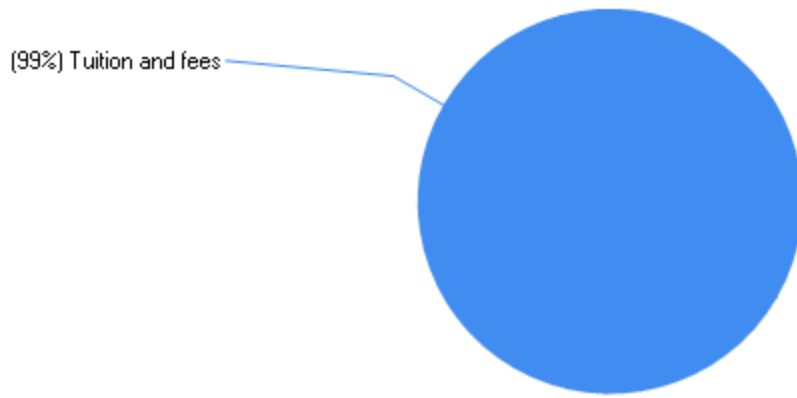
### Award and enrollment rates of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who entered the institution in 2009-10, by cohort

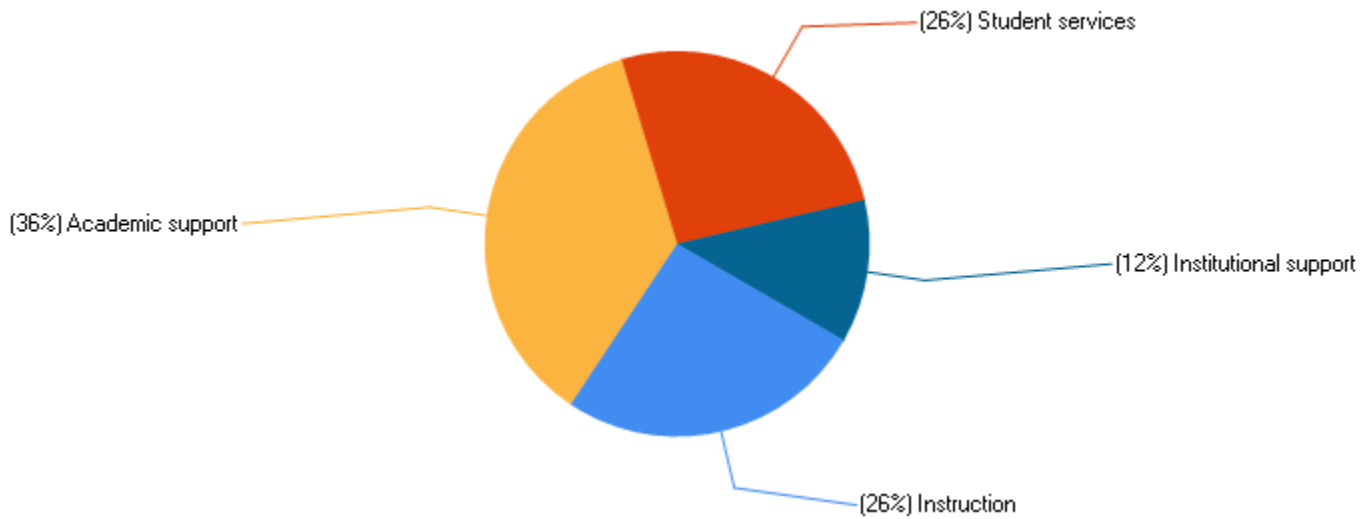
### Percent distribution of core revenues, by source: Fiscal year 2017

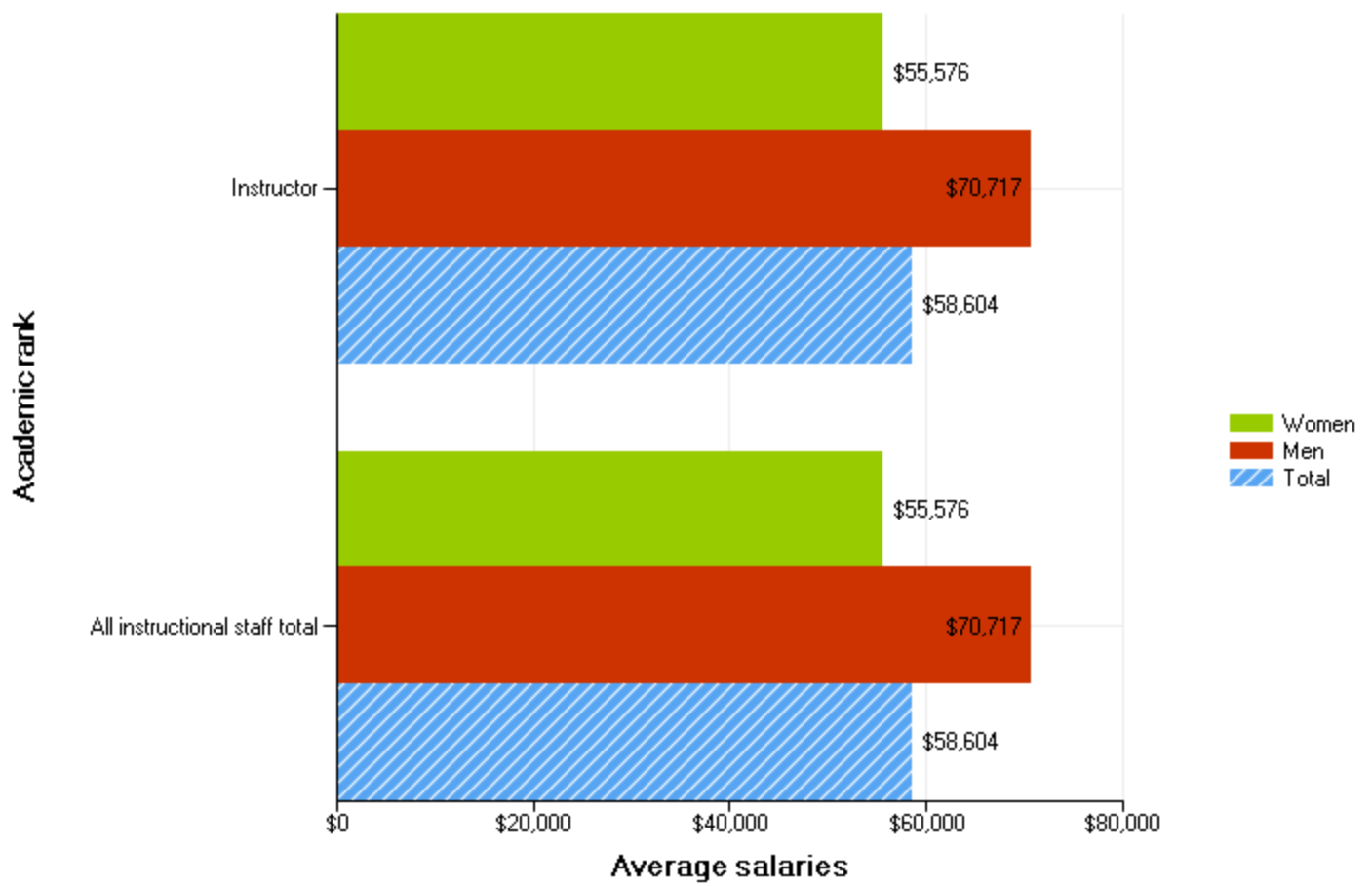

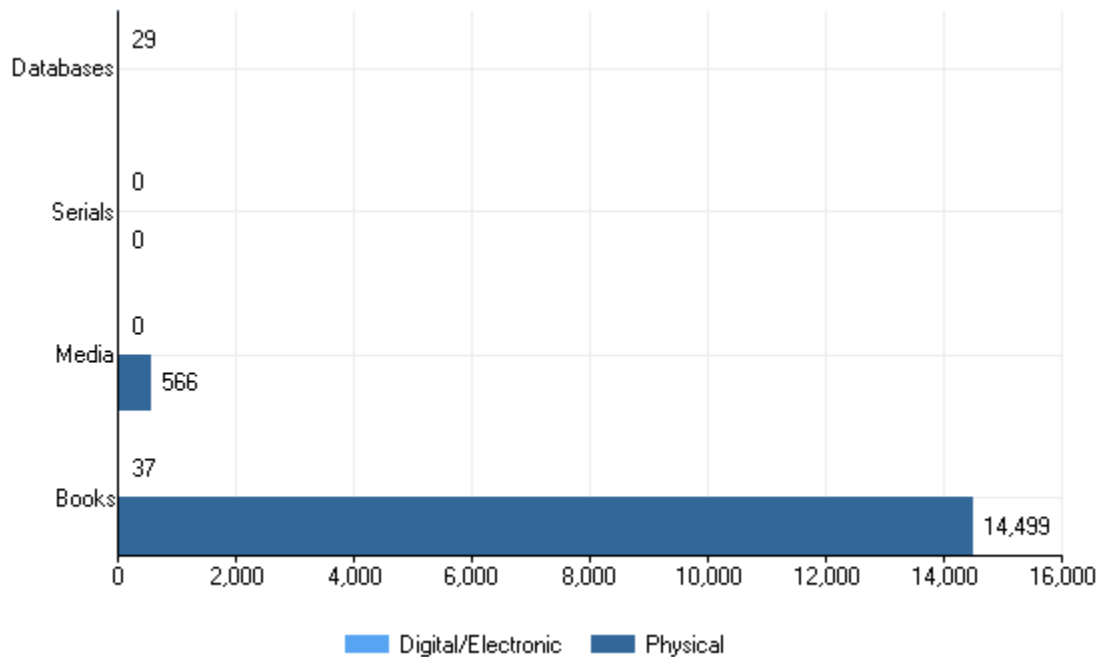

### Average salaries of full-time instructional nonmedical staff equated to 9-months worked, by academic rank and gender: Academic year 2017-18



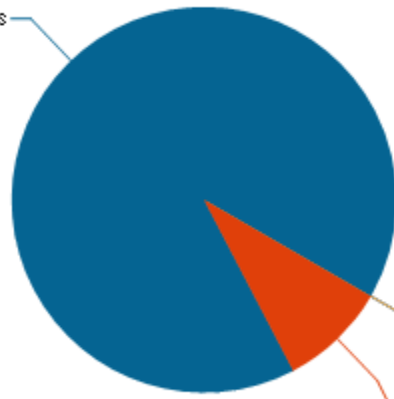
