

New Mexico Postsecondary Census Enrollment Trends Fall 2015-2025

Census enrollment is a snapshot of all enrolled students taken approximately 21 days after the first day of classes. This differs from the official end-of-semester enrollment that the New Mexico Higher Education Department typically reports, which is not available until several weeks after a semester ends. The delay allows time for institutions to finalize grades and submit, edit, and process their data files. Census enrollment offers an early look at what final enrollment is likely to be. While final numbers are typically slightly higher than the Census snapshot, overall trends are usually consistent.

The tables in this report reflect data submitted by New Mexico's public institutions following the Census date for each of the past nine fall semesters.

Each table includes four summary percent-change columns:

2015 to 2021 – Represents the change in enrollment from fall 2015 through the low point in fall 2021.

2021 to 2025 – Represents the change in enrollment since the implementation of the Opportunity Scholarship.

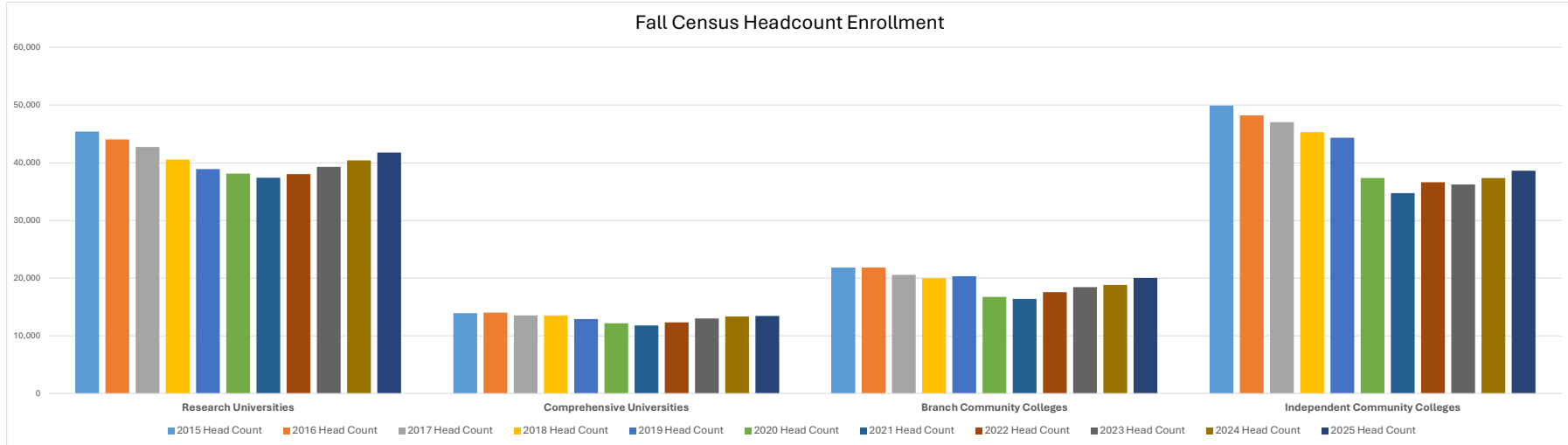

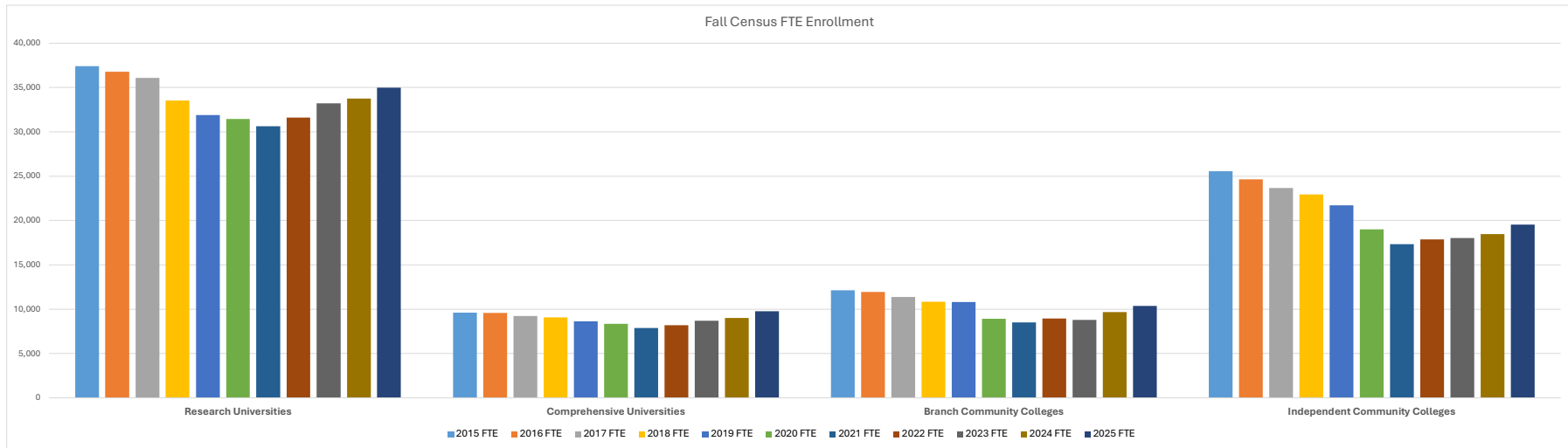
Fall Census Headcount Enrollment
