Mark Chisholm- we are trying to get the course level coding updated. Trying to make it unanimous for all institutions to make reporting easier. We have worked to come up with better definitions that were sent out last week for DAG review. Do these definitions work for you? So, we can get them added to the eDEAR manual so we can start collecting data using these terms. Charla Orozco- these look fine to me but would like to share with my institution leadership before committing. Mark Chisholm- please email me or Dina with any feedback. Changing codes on 1-4 from remedial to developmental they are not transferable or count towards any degree. The Gateway code is not really being used by many institutions currently, so we are proposing to get rid of this code. Vocational is another one we don't use often and would like to also get rid of this one as well. We would just have the new CO code for Co developmental, lower division, and upper division. This is all in an effort to make coding easier for reporting. I don't hear any comment or issues. We will get the eDEAR manual updated. Dina Advani- we are looking to add these codes for the summer but will not be mandated till the spring 2026.
