Notes:

- Undergraduate full-time equivalency (FTE) is calculated based on students enrolled in programs below the master's level, including those taking non-degree coursework. Total credit hours taken by these students are summed and divided by 15.
- Graduate full-time equivalency (FTE) is calculated based on students enrolled in master's-level or higher programs. For non-medical programs, total credit hours are summed and divided by 12. Students enrolled in medical programs are each counted as 1 FTE and added to the non-medical total to produce the final graduate FTE count. *UNM has 410
- This dataset includes students enrolled in credit-bearing courses, regardless of enrollment status. It includes concurrently enrolled high school students, undergraduates, graduate students, and students in non-degree
- No tribal colleges reported enrollment
- Navajo Technical University (NTU) did not report enrollment data for Fall 2017.
- Southwestern Indian Polytechnic Institute (SIPI) did not submit enrollment data for Fall 2022 or Fall 2023.
- Prior to 2021, Southeast New Mexico College (SENMNC) operated as NMSU-Carlsbad. Historical NMSU-Carlsbad data have been assigned to SENMC. FTE values for SENMC prior to 2021 are calculated using the Branch Community
- The methodology used to calculate FTE was updated in Fall 2023 and applied retroactively to prior years. As a result, data in this report may not align with figures published in previous reports.
