Students enrolled in medical programs are each counted as 1 FTE and are summed with the values from non-medical students for the final total.
- Students included in this dataset are Students enrolled in credit-bearing courses, regardless of their enrollment status. As such, concurrently enrolled high school Students, undergraduate Students, graduate Students, and Students in non-degree tracks are included.
- No tribal colleges provided enrollment data in Fall 2013.
- NTU did not provide enrollment data in Fall 2017.
- SIPI did not submit enrollment data for Fall 2022 and Fall 2024.
- Prior to 2021, SENMC operated as NMSU-CA; it has been assigned the historical NMSU-CA data. FTE values for SENMC prior to 2021 are calculated using the Branch Community College methodology.
- The methodology used to calculated FTE has been adjusted for Fall 2024 and applied to prior years. As such, data in this report may not align with prior reports.
