

About:

The A Little Hope Foundation helps underrepresented students with outstanding achievement and the ambition and drive to pursue higher education in selected fields that will equip them to tackle complex social and economic issues affecting their communities.

Scholarship Program:

A Little Hope Foundation provides up to \$10,000 in scholarships annually. Students have the opportunity to receive one \$2,500 scholarship a year. The scholarships are granted based upon assessment of need and university selection.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be an underrepresented minority student who demonstrates high performance and self-drive as evidenced by outstanding achievement in school and community or work-related activities.

Application Deadlines:

Fall Semester - June 30 Spring Semester - October 30
