- Data Summary Report Trend Fall 2021 (Mark shared data reports on enrollment data going back to 2005 to 2021 that can sort by institution and sector, Mark will be sharing with LFC and will send out to group. Mark also pulled one pagers for institutions with various info and data – source College Score Card. Profiles could be posted online)
- 3. Changes to eDEAR
 - a. Gender field adding codes "U" and "X" (*Discussion on finalizing codes for the Gender Field. "U" for unidentified and "X" anything that is not Female or Male. Issues of students being forced or are unable to identify came up. Dina commented that schools would have 3 semesters to institute. Mark commented that the field could be optional so it doesn't fail an edit. Dep Sec. Trujillo provided update that other agencies are discussing timelines on this. Some agencies easier than others because of consistencies. Spring 2023 as a pilot.* Group seem to agree that "N" as non-reported and "X" as non-binary)



- b. Course level field review (Mark commented that the course level. Dina provided the updated codes as they were not in the eDear manual. She commented that the data might not be sent because the codes are not being used anymore. The codes need to be better defined than they are right now. Example CTE instead of vocational. What needs to get done to start getting this data again? Mark will check with CCA on their definition on these course levels. Possible letter to Provost requiring this info. Multiple versions of eDear manual that give appropriate instructions for what version the institutions are working on. Isaac proposed using a header)
- c. Pilot files for Spring 2022
- d. Collection of files UNM-Medical (Only applies to UNM, for historical has provided 12 but it is only for MD students which causes confusion since it refers to the HSC. Mark suggested UNM stop reporting it causes duplication issues. Dina suggested starting Summer 2022)
