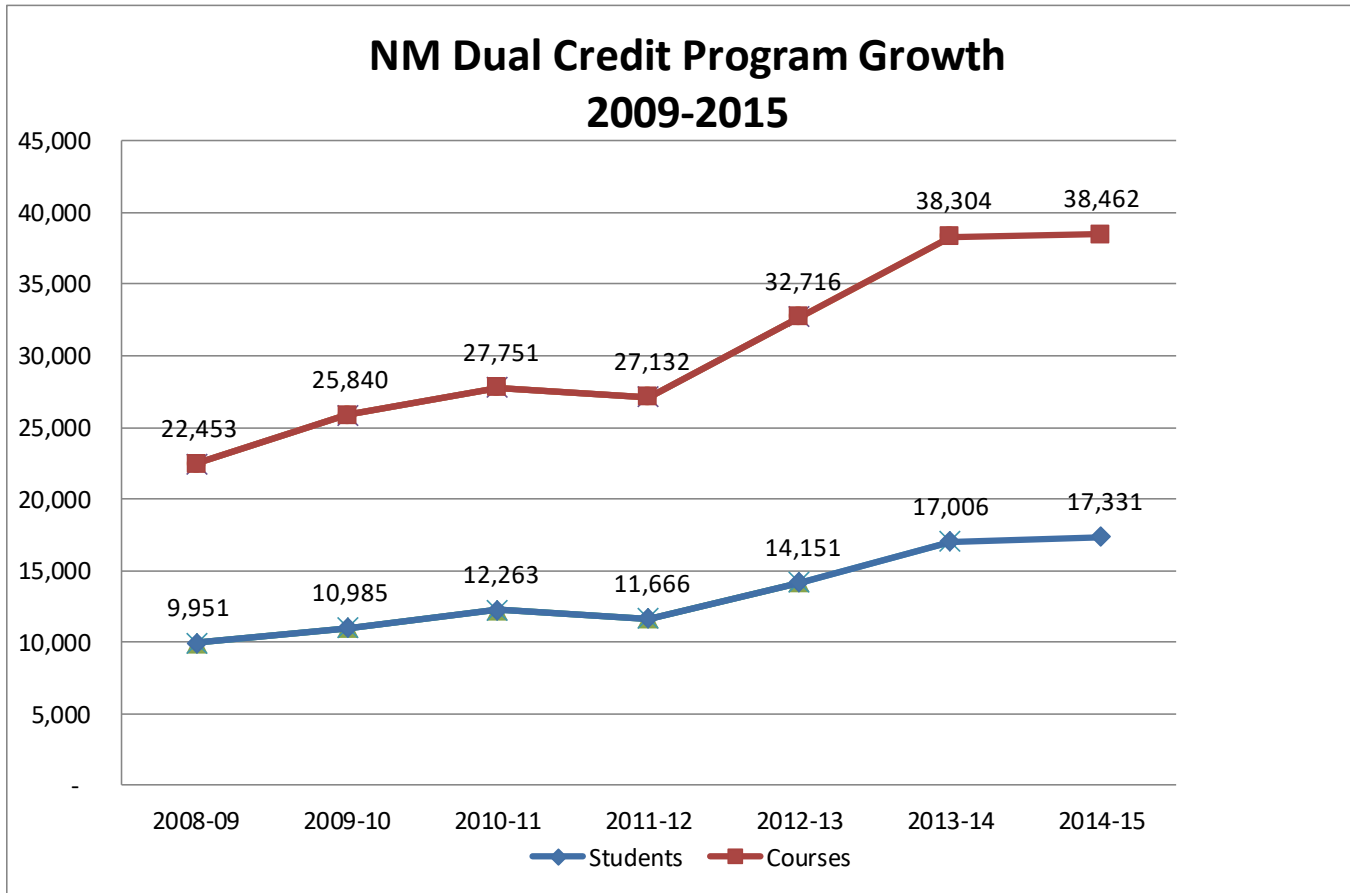

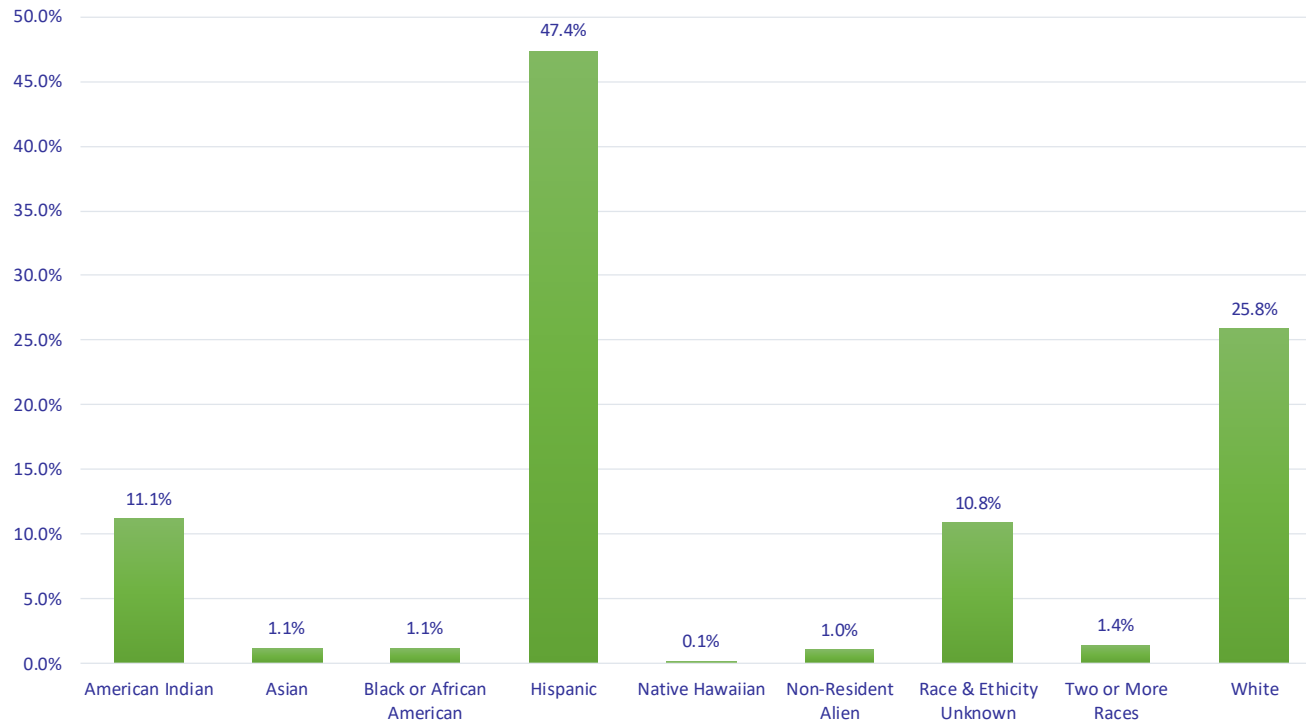

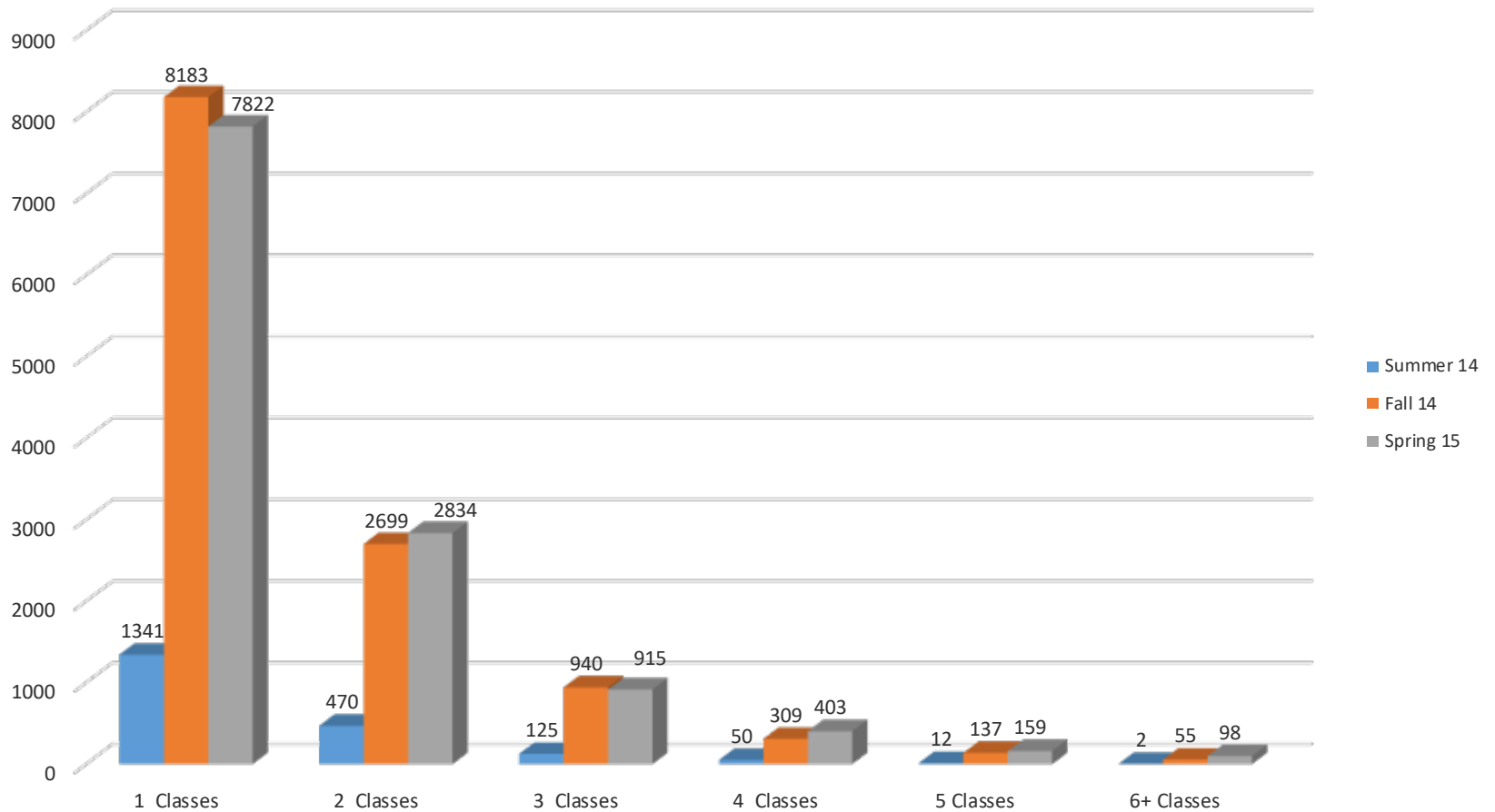

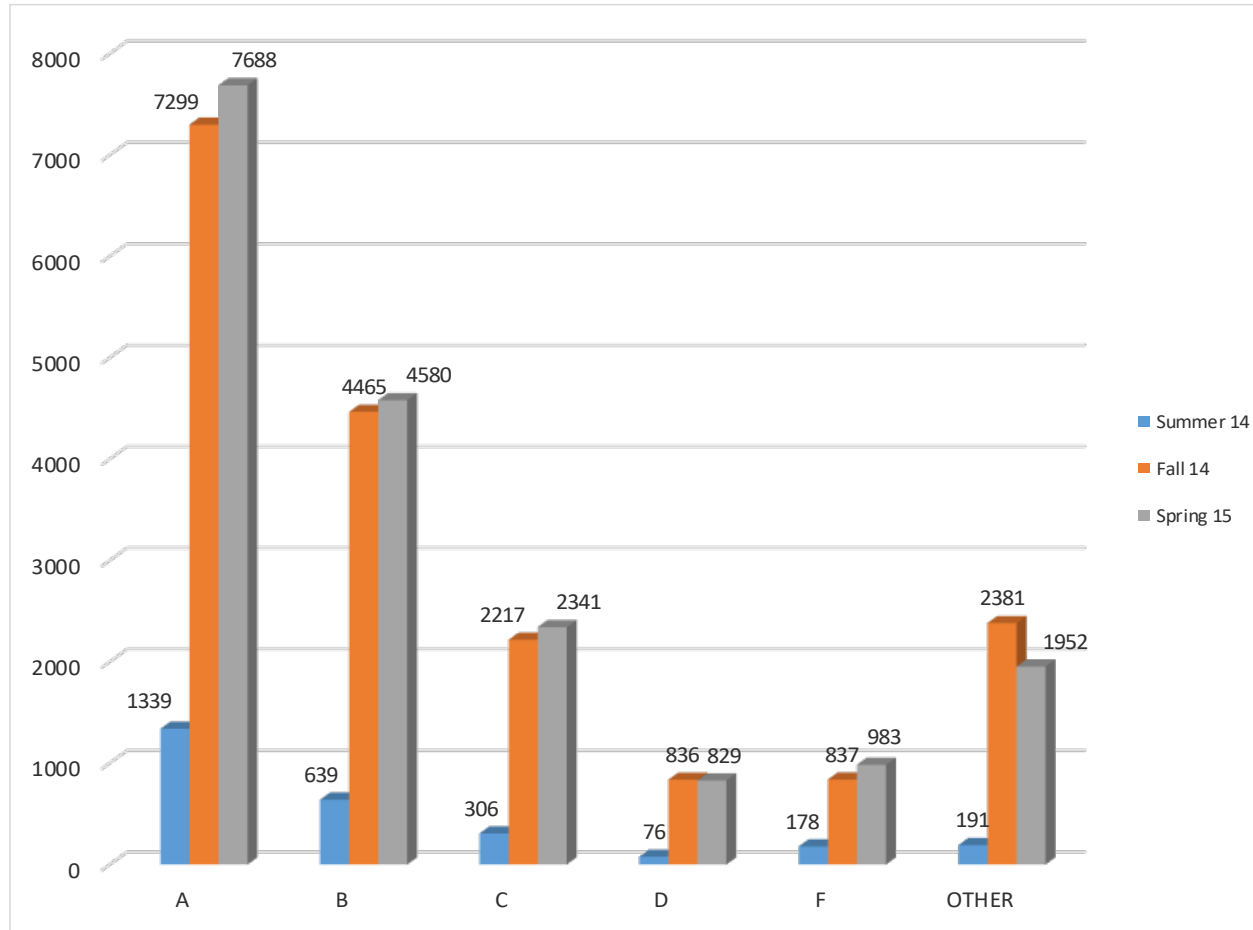
# Number of Classes Taken AY14-15

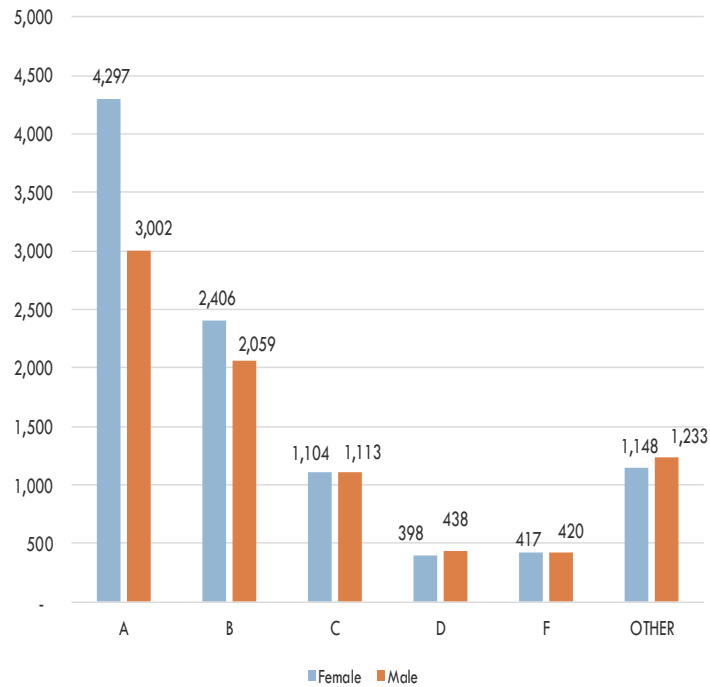

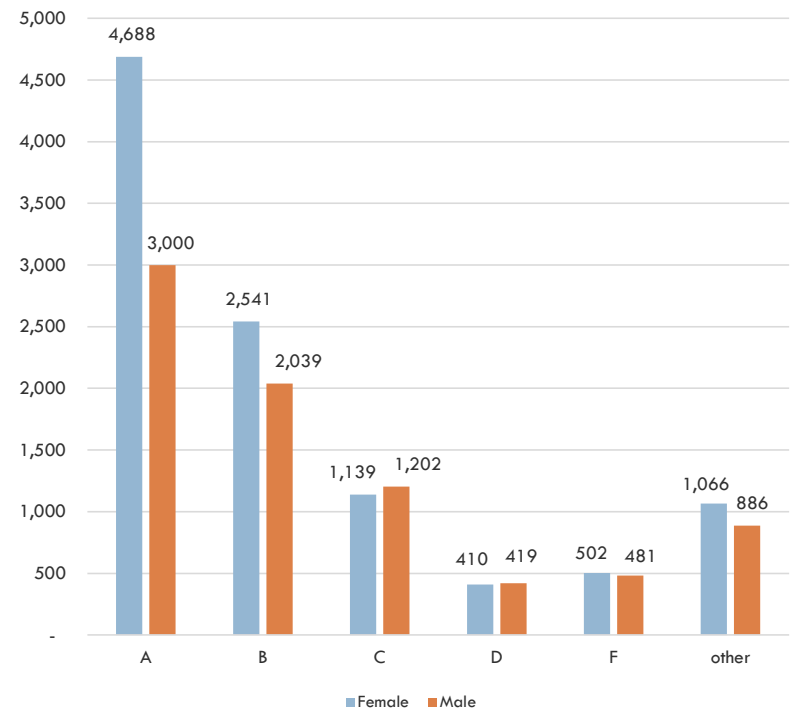
# Course Grade Distribution by Gender

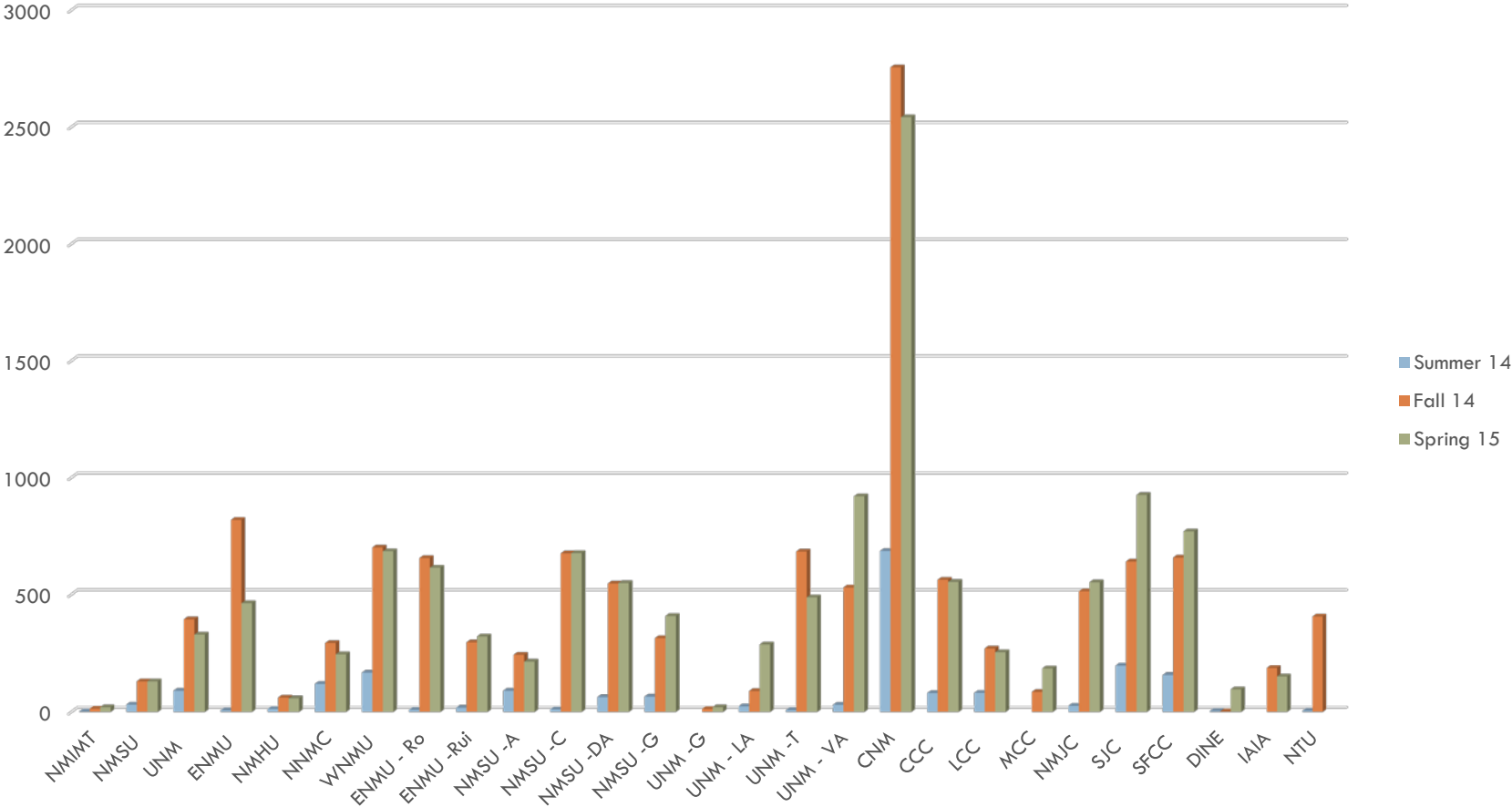

# Dual Credit Enrollment at Postsecondary Institutions

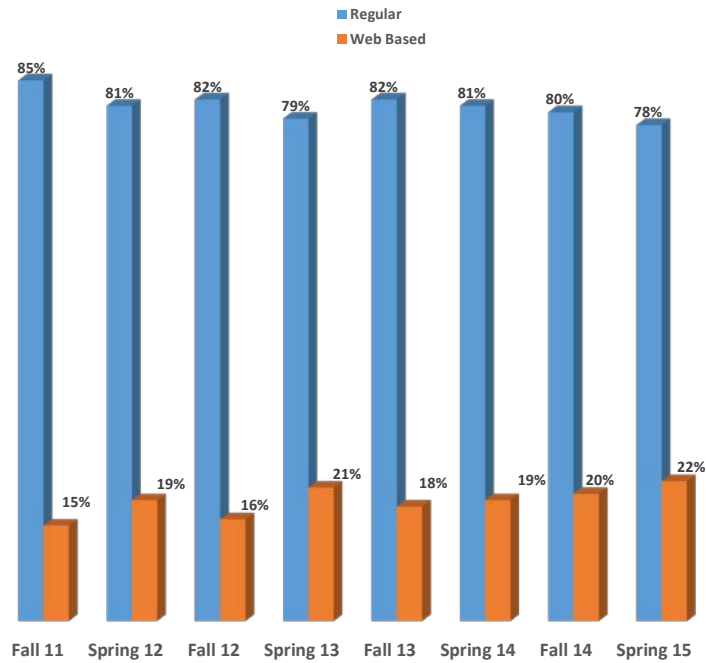

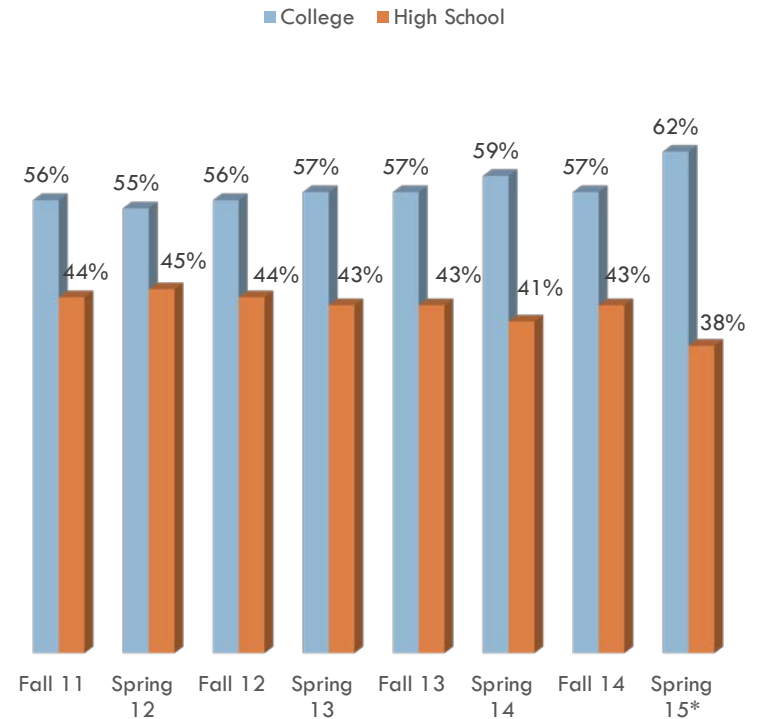
