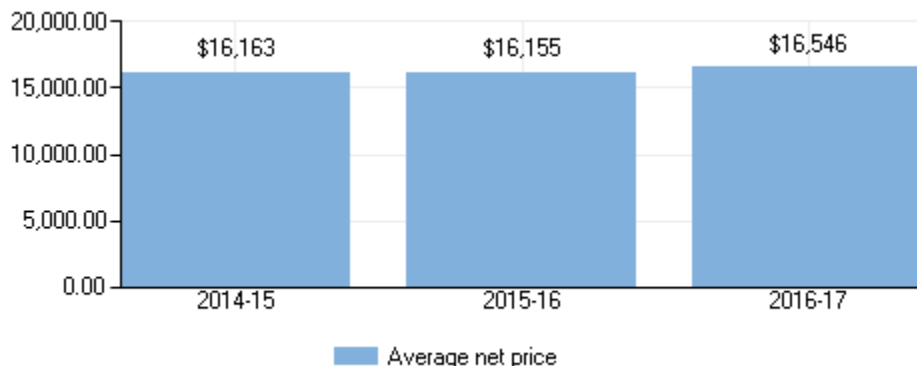

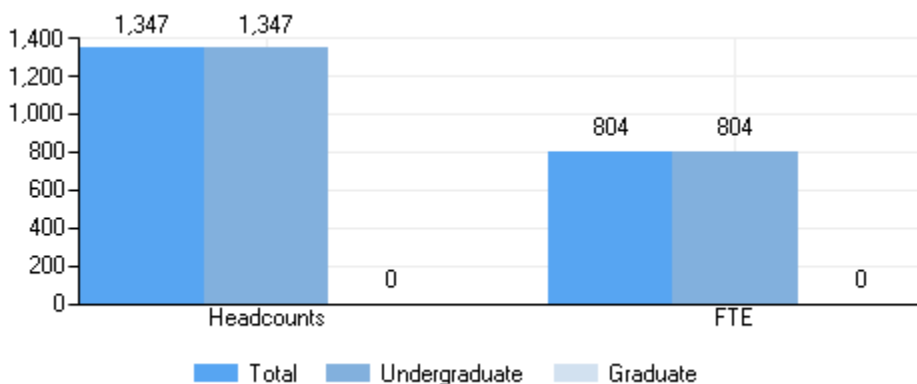

### Unduplicated 12-month headcount and total FTE, by student level: 2017-18

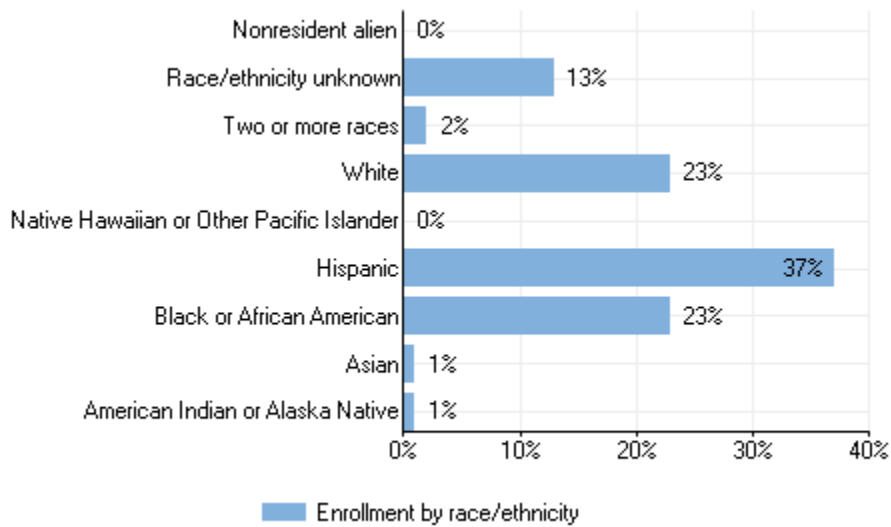


### Enrollment by gender, student level, and full- and part-time status: Fall 2017

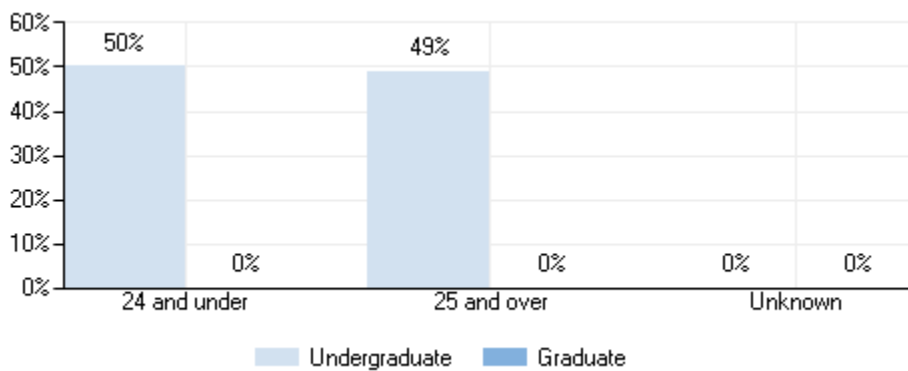

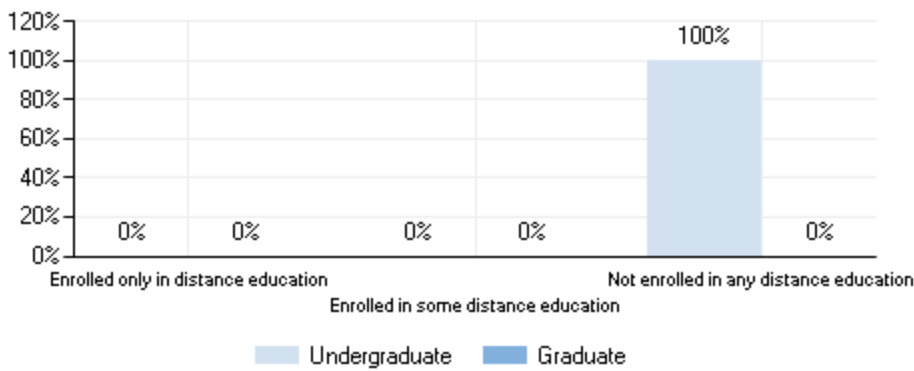
### Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2017

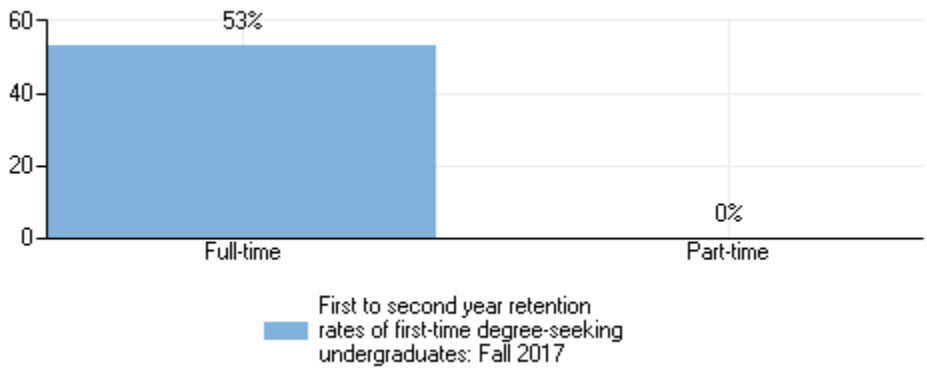

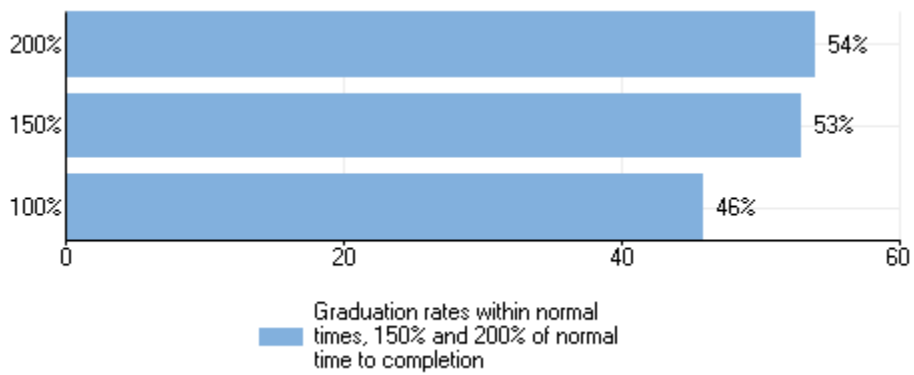

**First to second year retention rates of first-time degree-seeking undergraduates: Fall 2017**



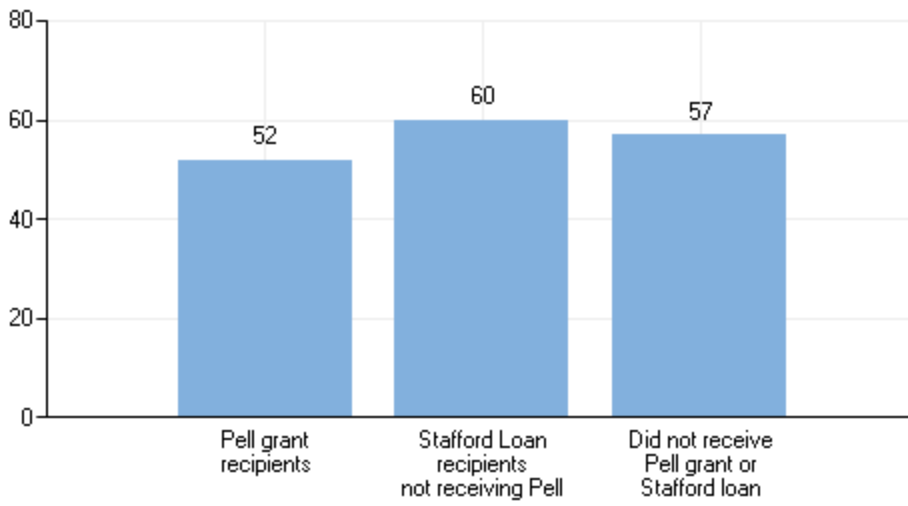

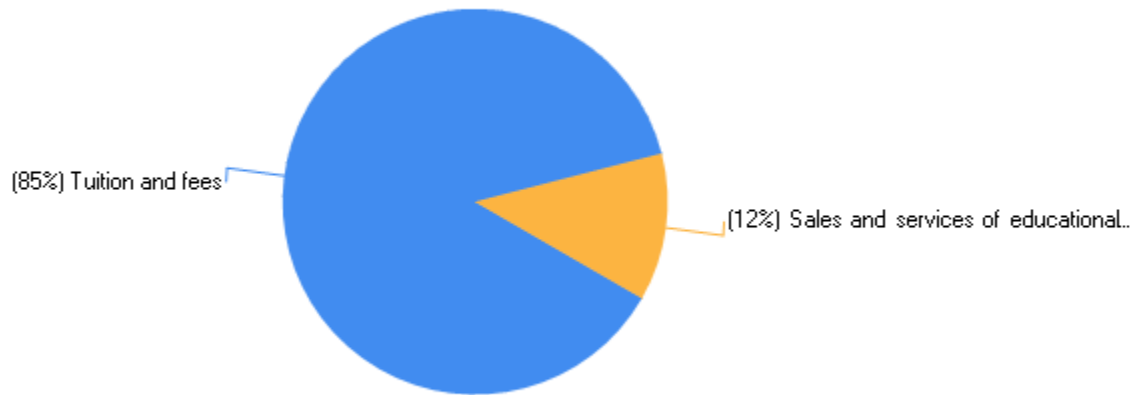

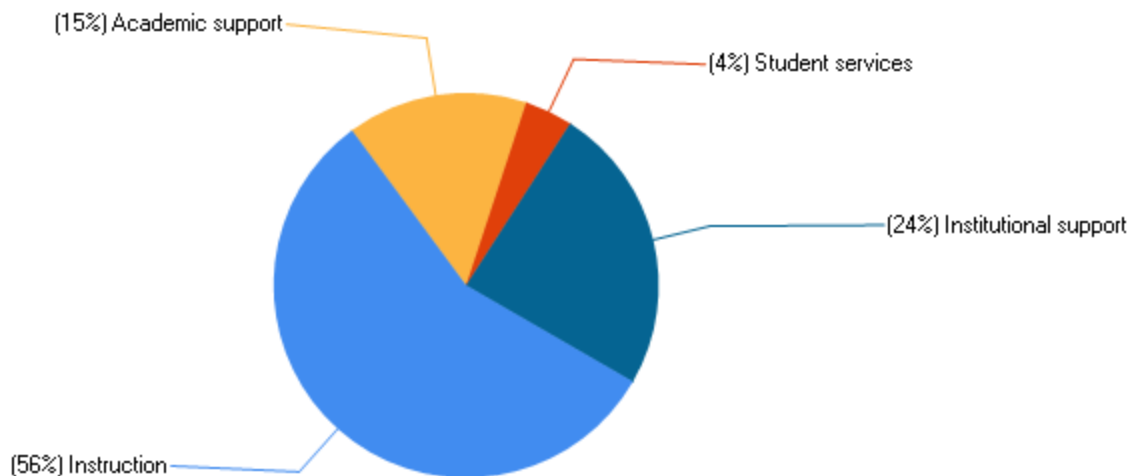
### Percent distribution of core revenues, by source: Fiscal year 2017
