Strategy for identifying <b>essential</b> staff needs	Managing occupancy to < 25% capacity, managing flow, face masks, social distancing, and training
Strategy for testing and rapid response testing	Identified partnership with local or regional testing center/facility, or capacity to test on campus
Strategy for influx of cases or outbreak	Identified partnership with local or regional testing center/facility in the event that campus resources are unavailable
Strategy for contact tracing	COVID coordinator identified on campus to initiate contact tracing and communicate with the NMHED rapid response team and NMDOH contact tracers if necessary
Strategy for screening students, faculty, and staff	Temperature checks, questionnaires on symptoms and travel, COVID-19 positive contacts, COVID-19 testing, and appointments
Strategy for limiting campus visitors	Setting up requests and appointments for nonessential visitors and managing traffic flow
Strategy for screening campus visitors	Temperature checks, questionnaires on symptoms and travel, COVID-19 positive contacts, COVID-19 testing, and appointments
Protocols for cleaning and disinfecting	Protocol for daily/regular cleaning of public and shared spaces
Protocols for minimizing exposure in classrooms	Managing flow, face masks, and social distancing
Protocols for minimizing exposure in laboratory spaces	Managing occupancy, managing flow, face masks, and social distancing
Protocols for minimizing exposure in other campus facilities	Managing occupancy, scheduling appointments, managing flow, face masks, and social distancing
Protocols for minimizing exposure in residence halls	Limited residence hall capacity; No double occupancy, cleaning protocols, identified isolation space, and proper COVID-safe practices including face masks and proper social distancing where shared space is necessary
