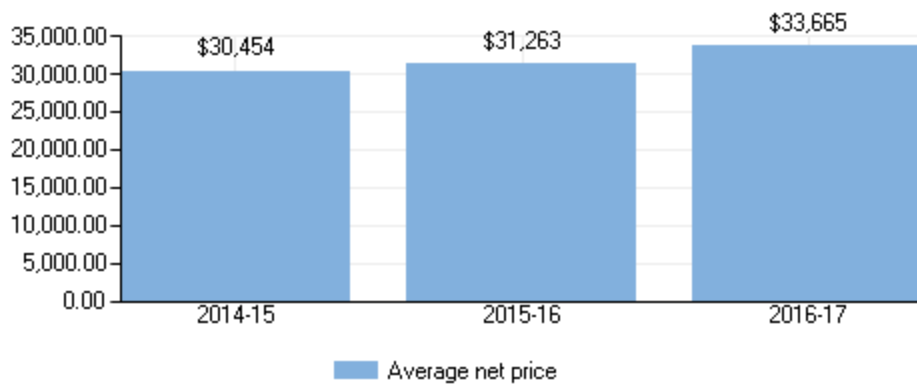

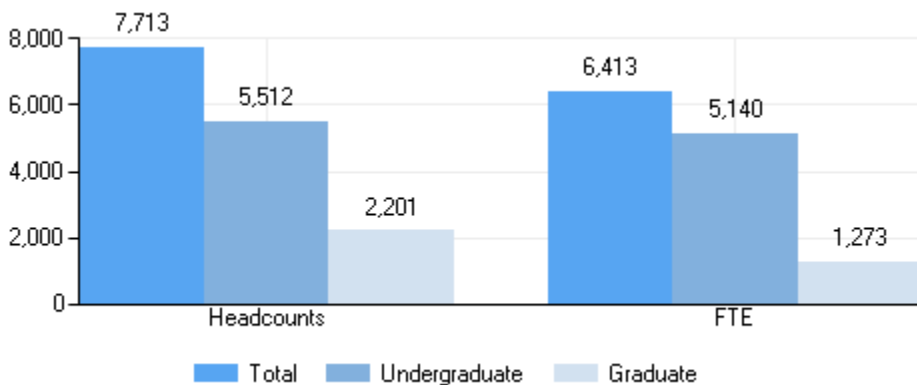

**Unduplicated 12-month headcount and total FTE, by student level: 2017-18**

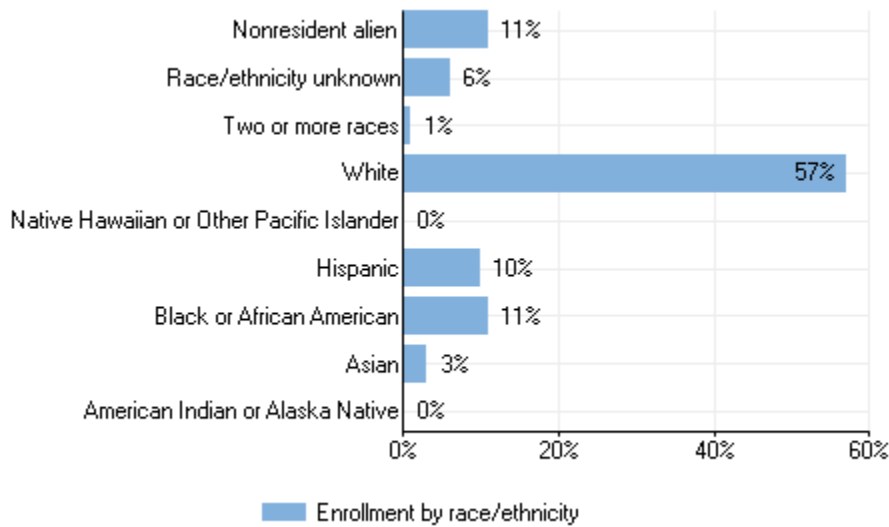


**Enrollment by gender, student level, and full- and part-time status: Fall 2017**

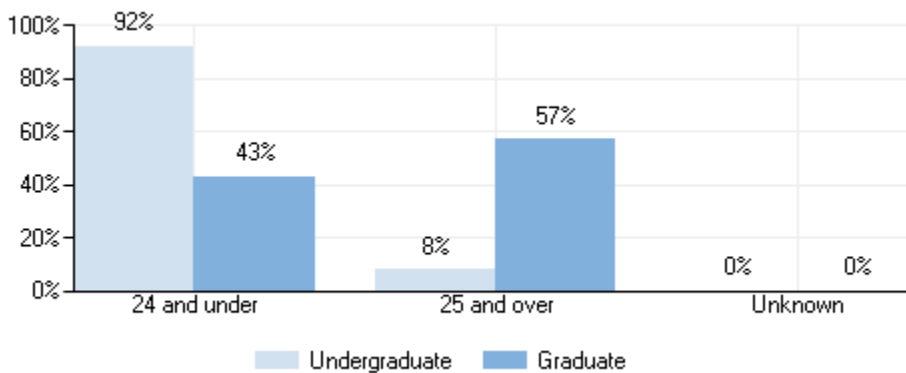

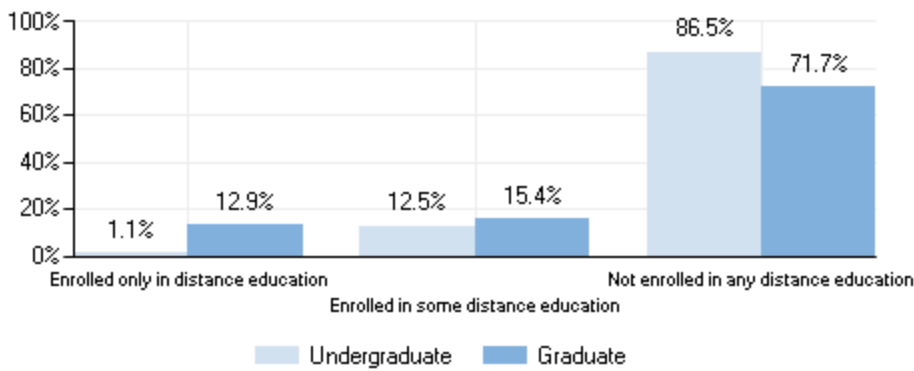
### Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2017



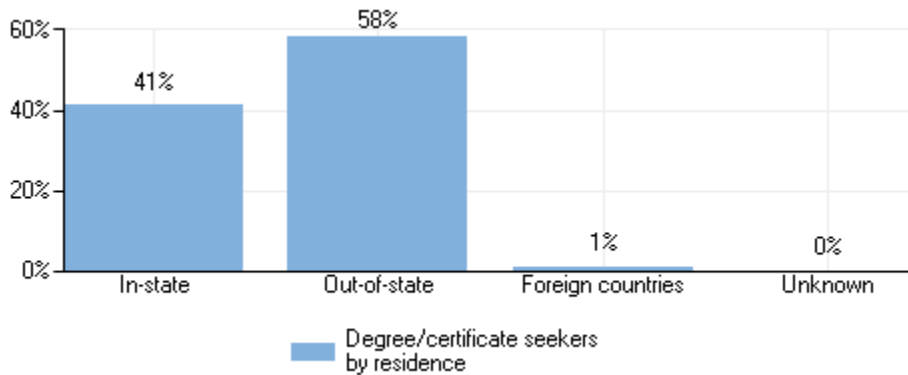
### Percent of all students enrolled, by age: Fall 2017

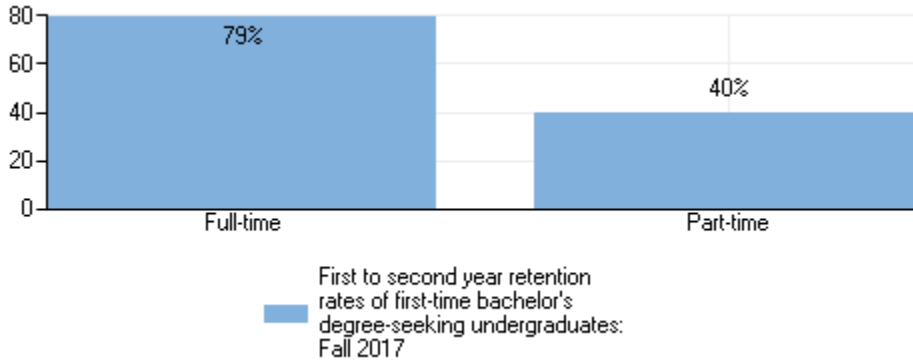

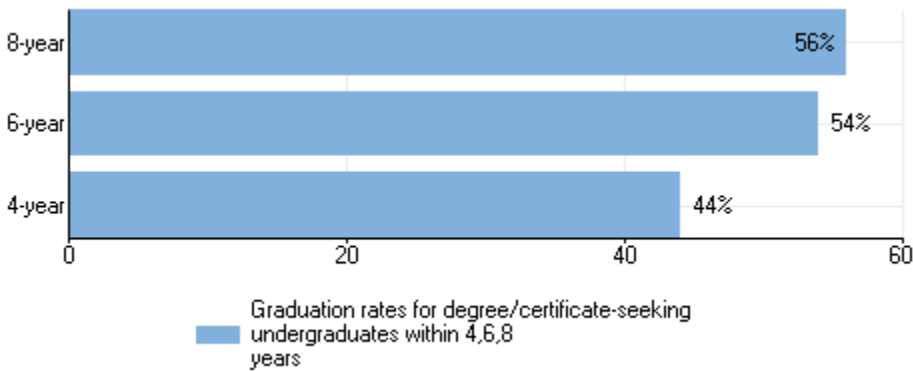

### First to second year retention rates of first-time bachelor's degree-seeking undergraduates: Fall 2017



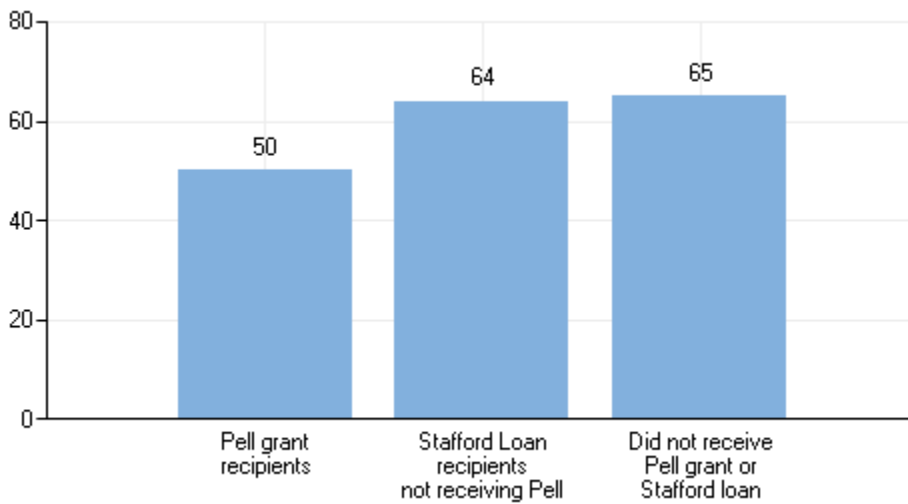

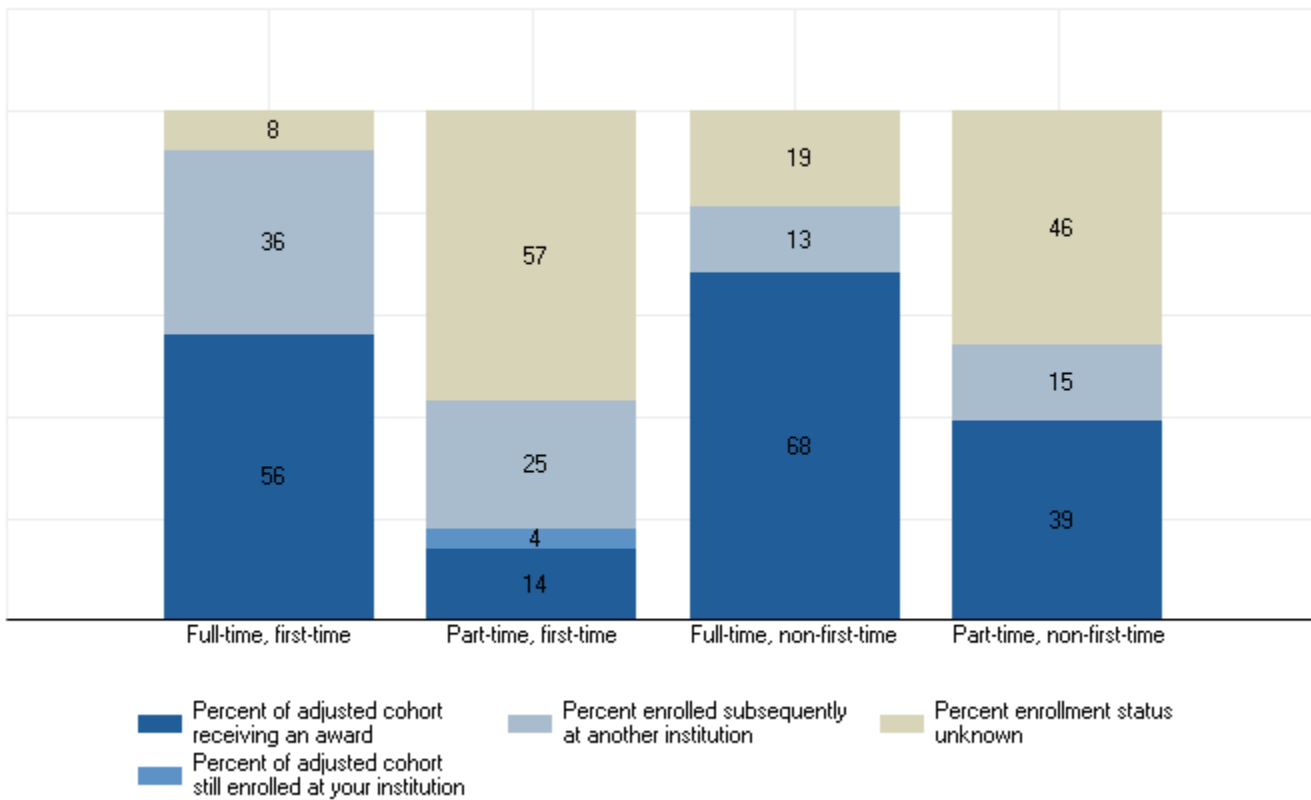

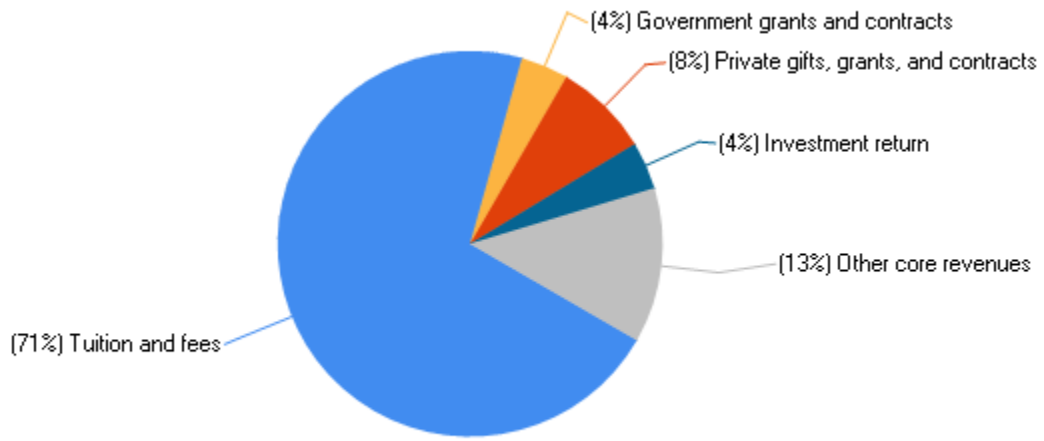
**Award and enrollment rates of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who entered the institution in 2009-10, by cohort**

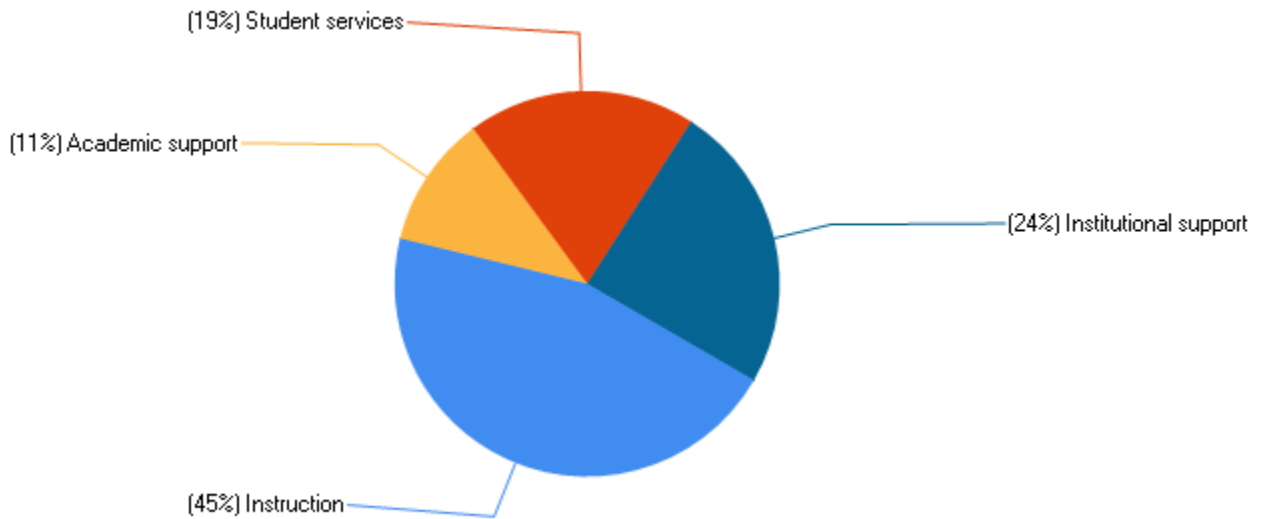
**Percent distribution of core revenues, by source: Fiscal year 2017**

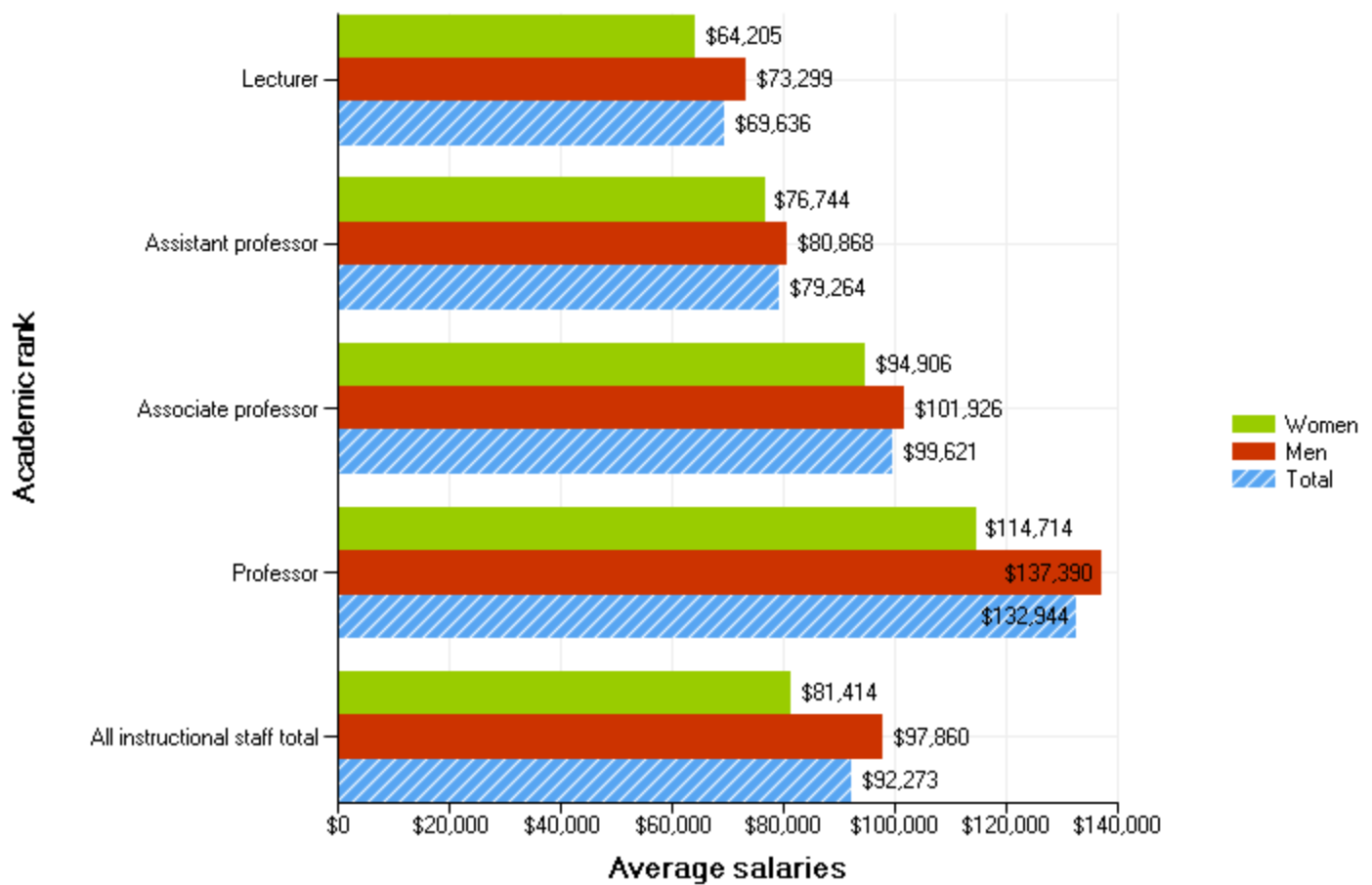

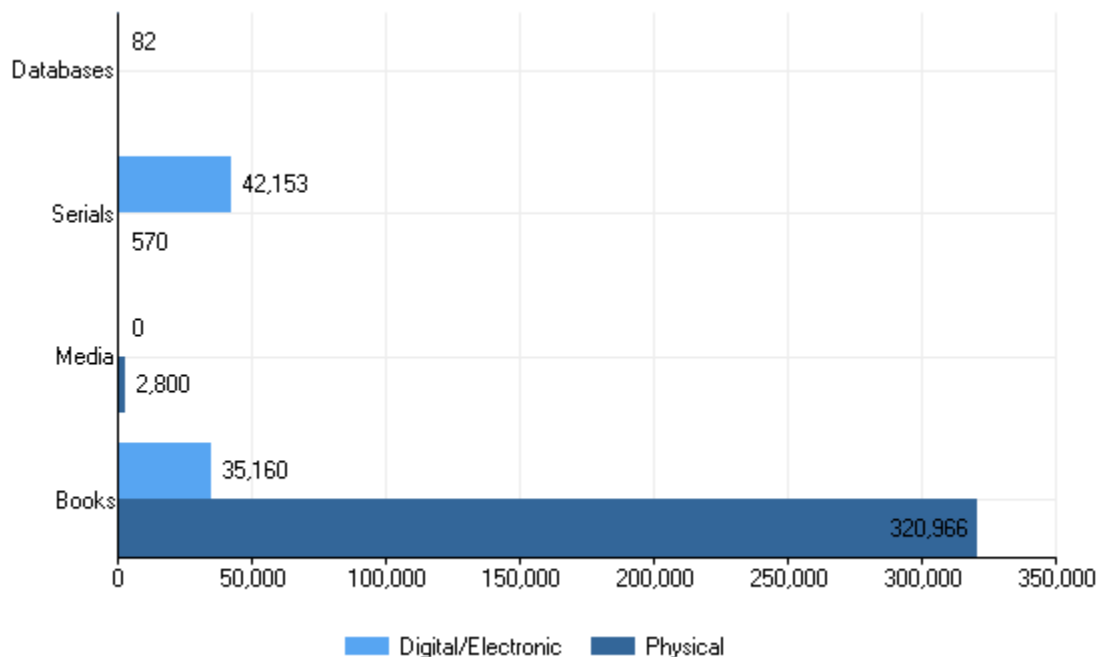
