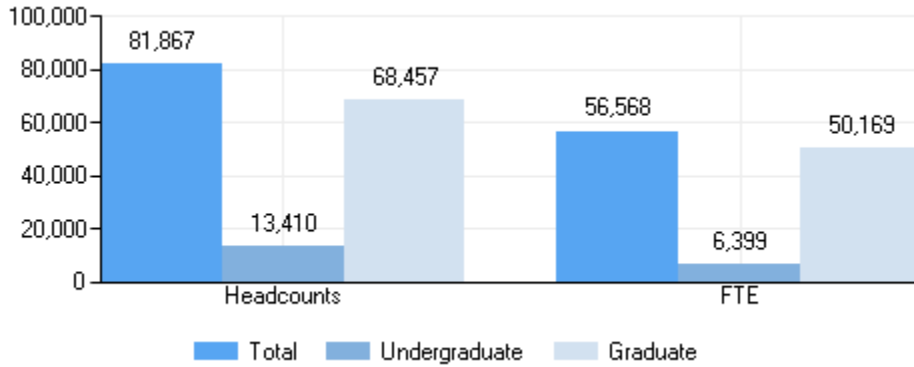

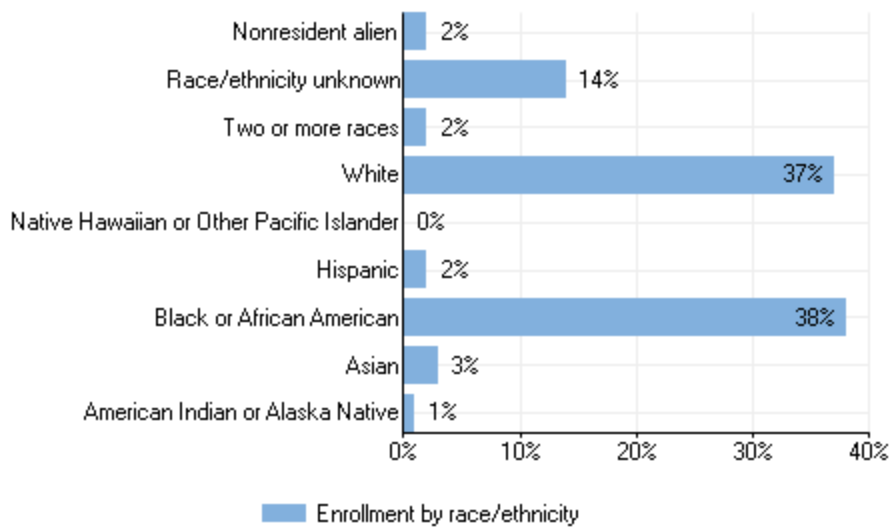
### Unduplicated 12-month headcount and total FTE, by student level: 2017-18



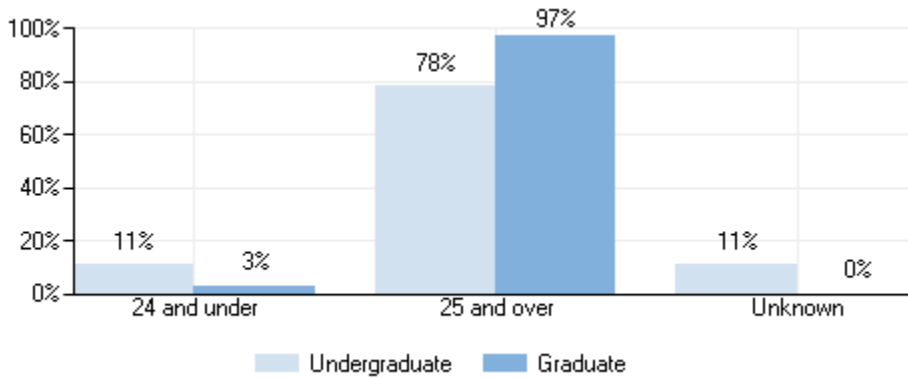

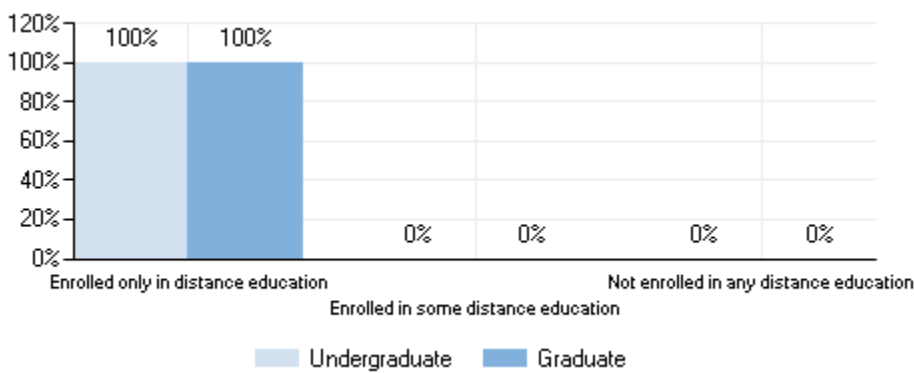
### Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2017



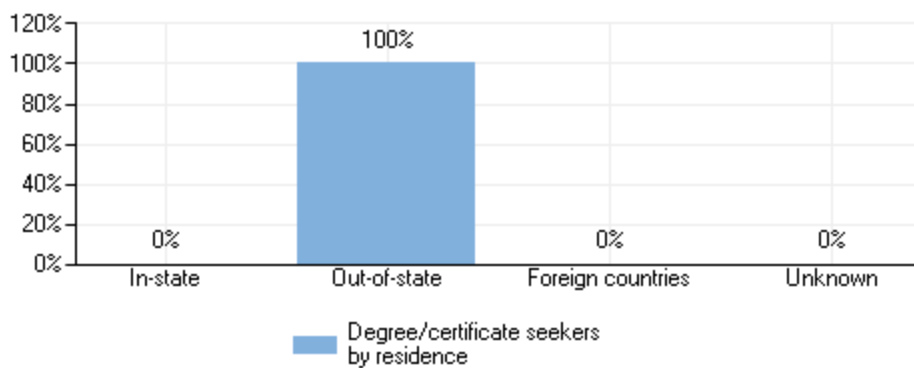
**Percent of all students enrolled, by age: Fall 2017**

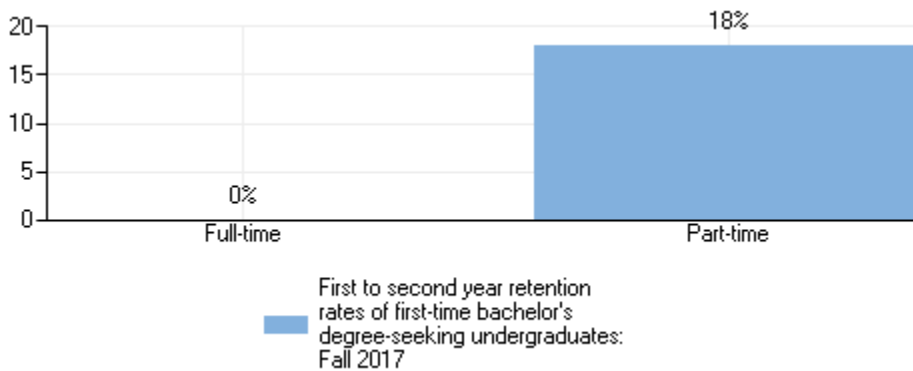

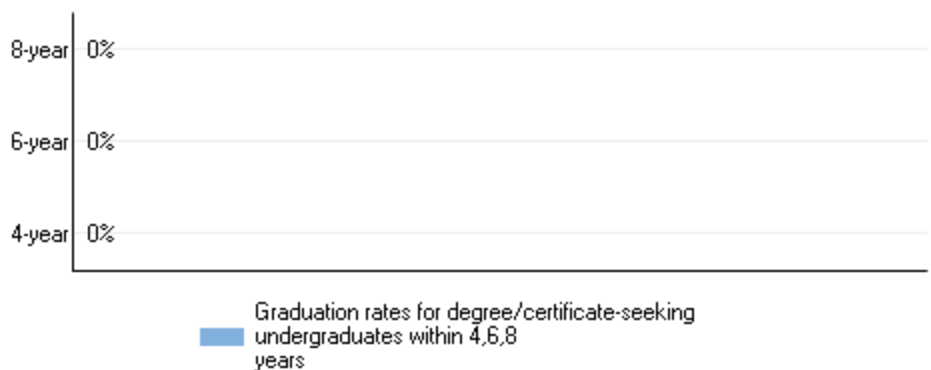

#### First to second year retention rates of first-time bachelor's degree-seeking undergraduates: Fall 2017



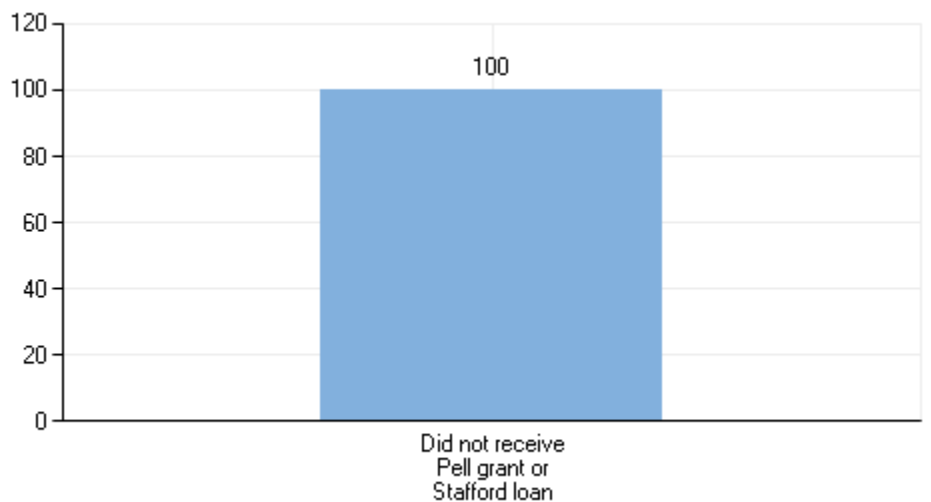

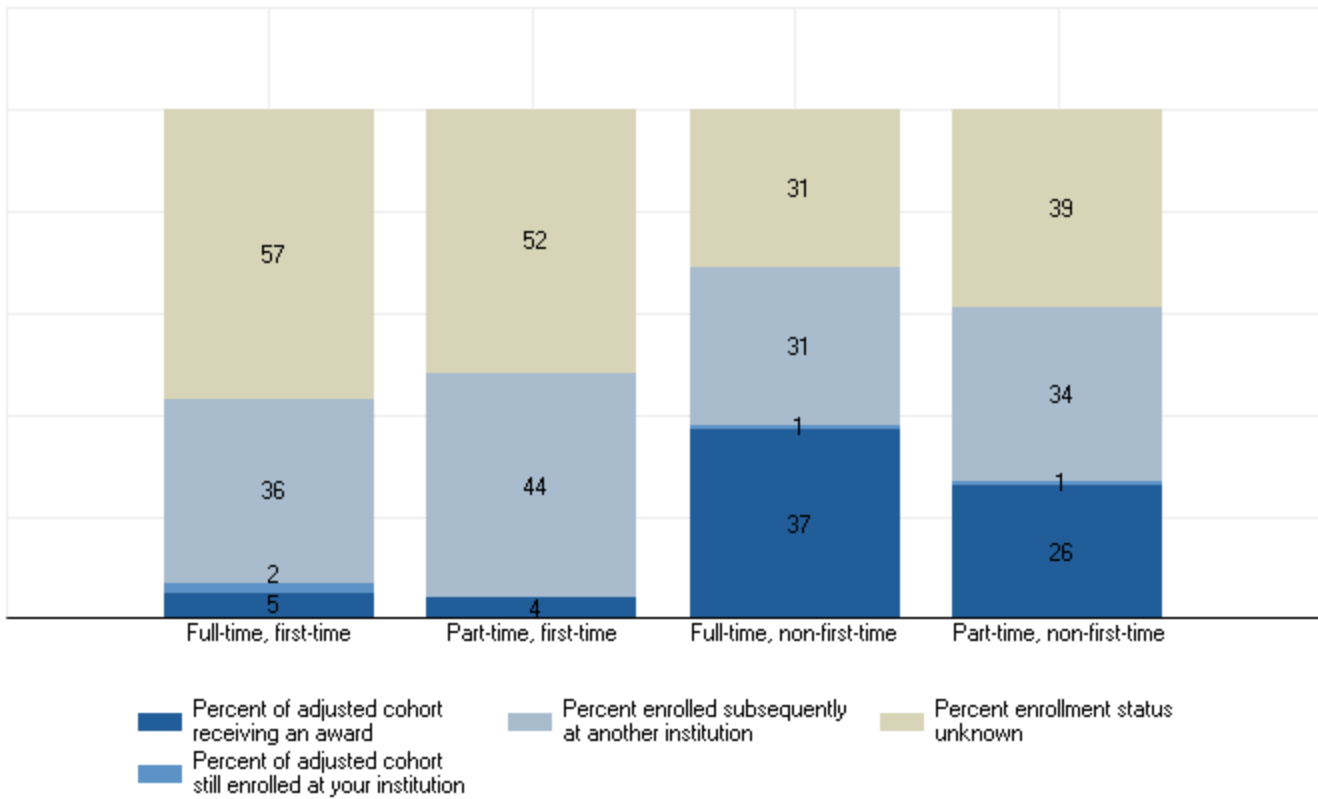

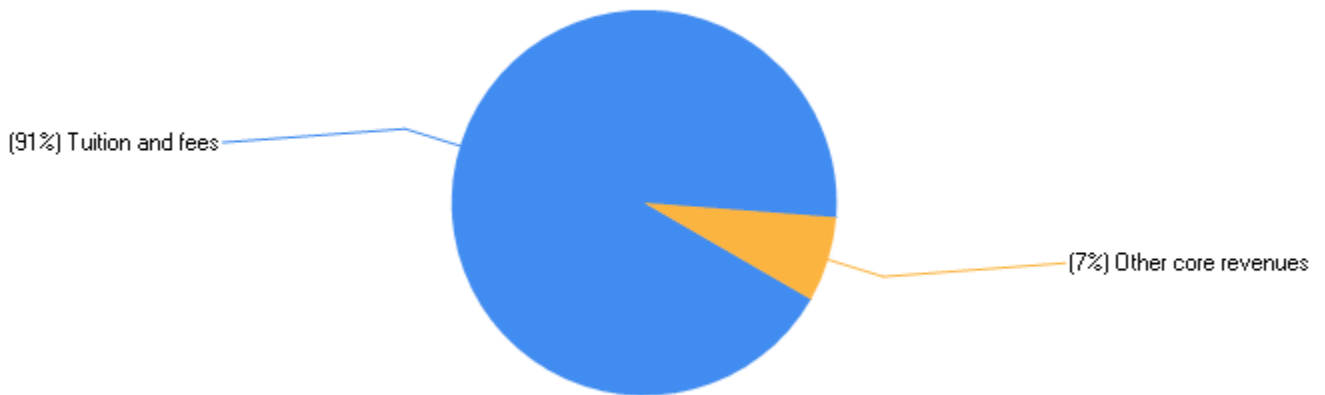
**Award and enrollment rates of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who entered the institution in 2009-10, by cohort**

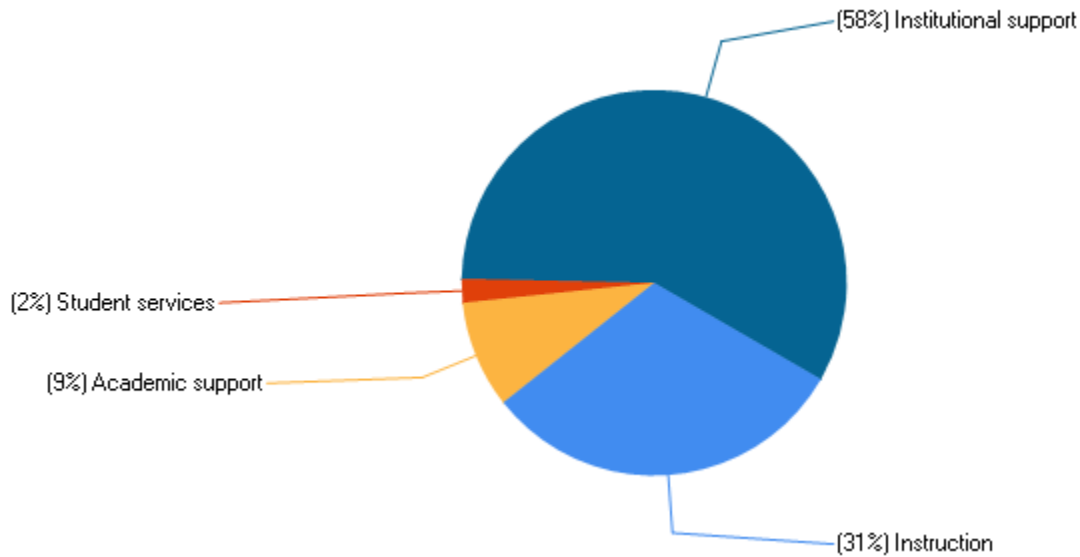

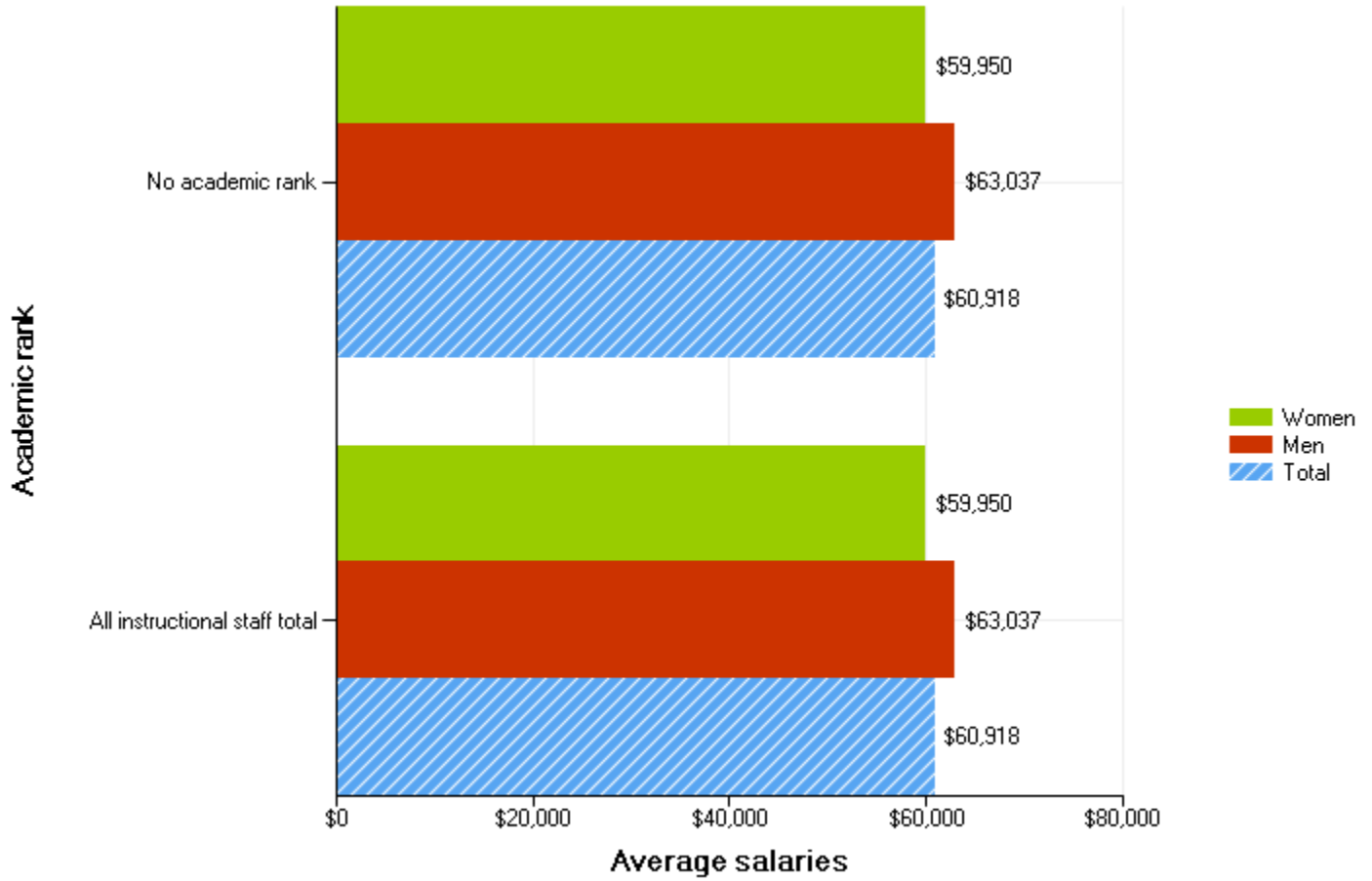

**Number of full-time instructional, research, and public service staff, by tenure status: Fall 2017**



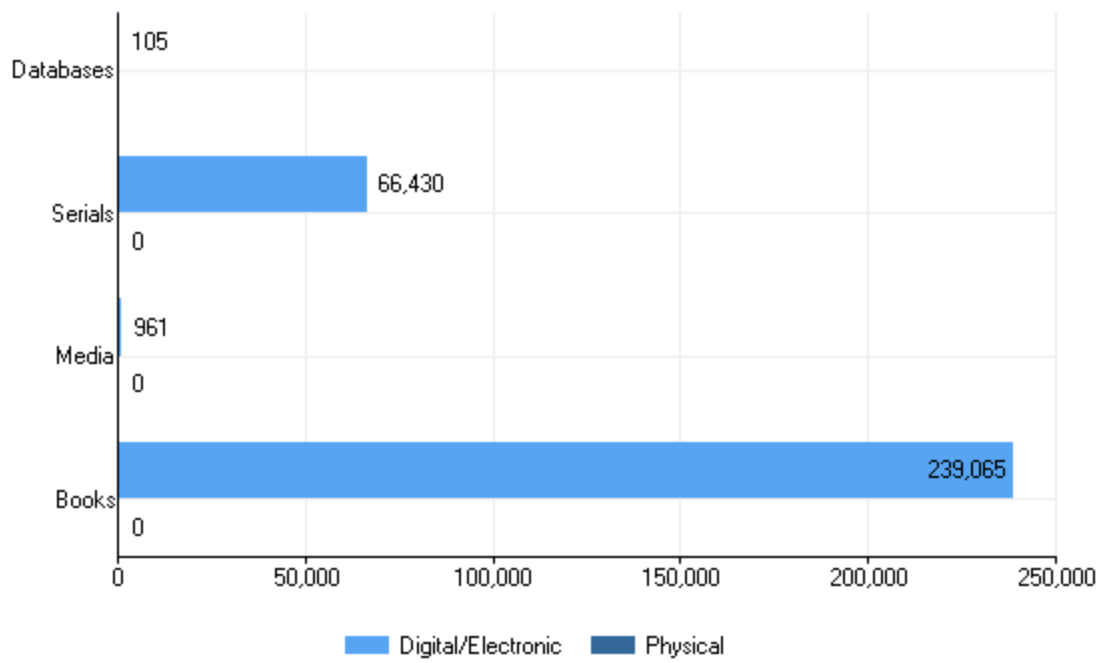
